



ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Lochfyne, gunpowder-works, Furnace comprises the major part of the remains of the gunpowder-works at Lochfyne, Furnace, which are situated on the W bank of the Leacann Water, 400m NW of the old iron-furnace. The area to be scheduled measures 340m from N to S by up to 120m transversely, to include the northern part of the gunpowder-works and an area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmichael Glassary and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

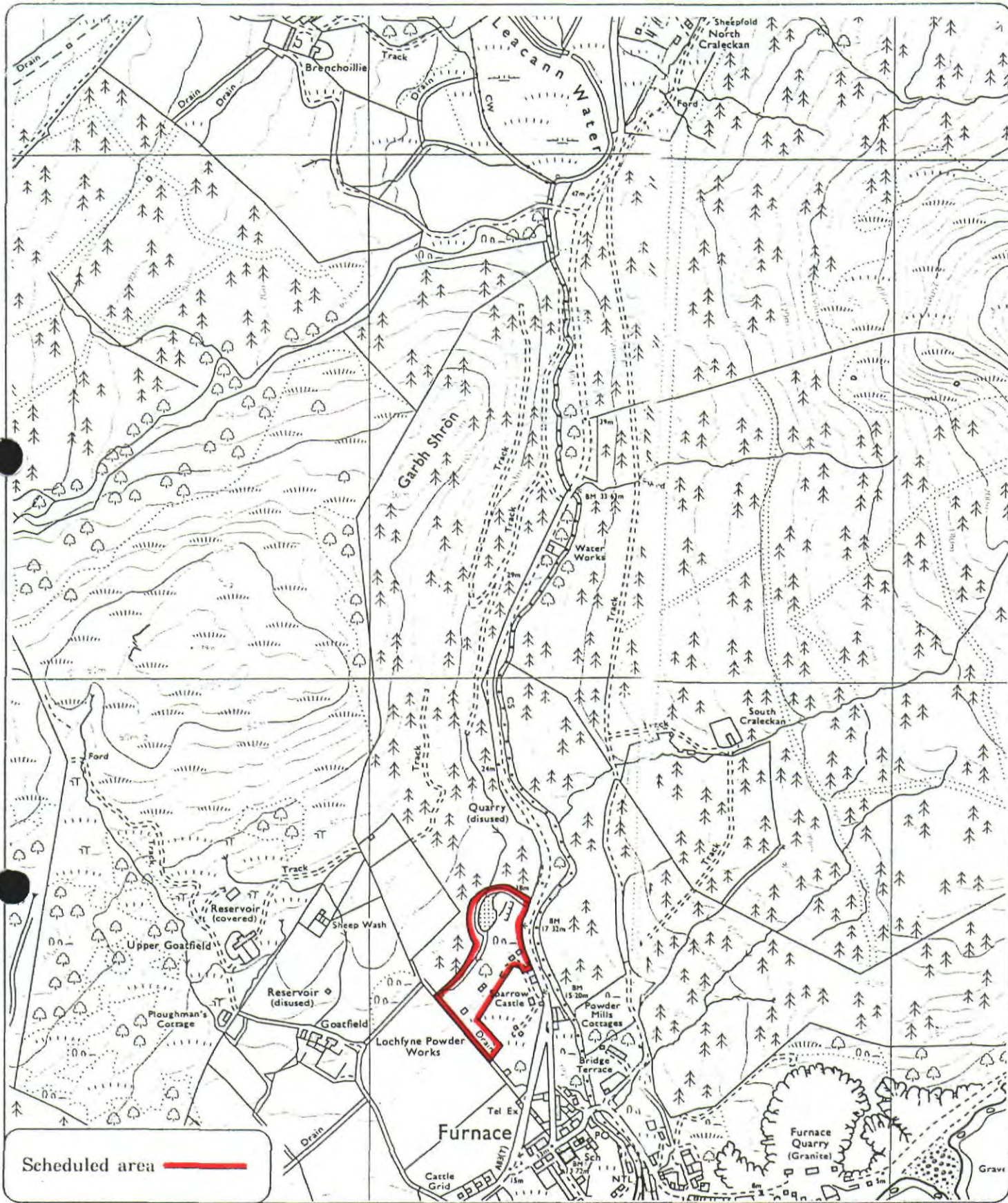

Scheduled area

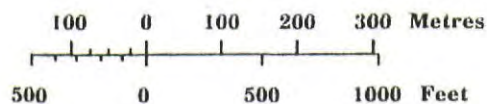
