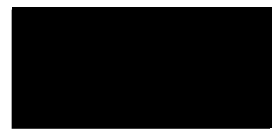

The monument known as Dun Nighean Righ Lochlainn, dun, Loch an Duin, Loch Portain comprises a late-prehistoric fortified settlement, or dun, on a small island in Loch an Duin. The area to be scheduled consists of a circle 30m in diameter to include the dun, the whole of the islet on which it stands and a portion of the loch-bed around it. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the

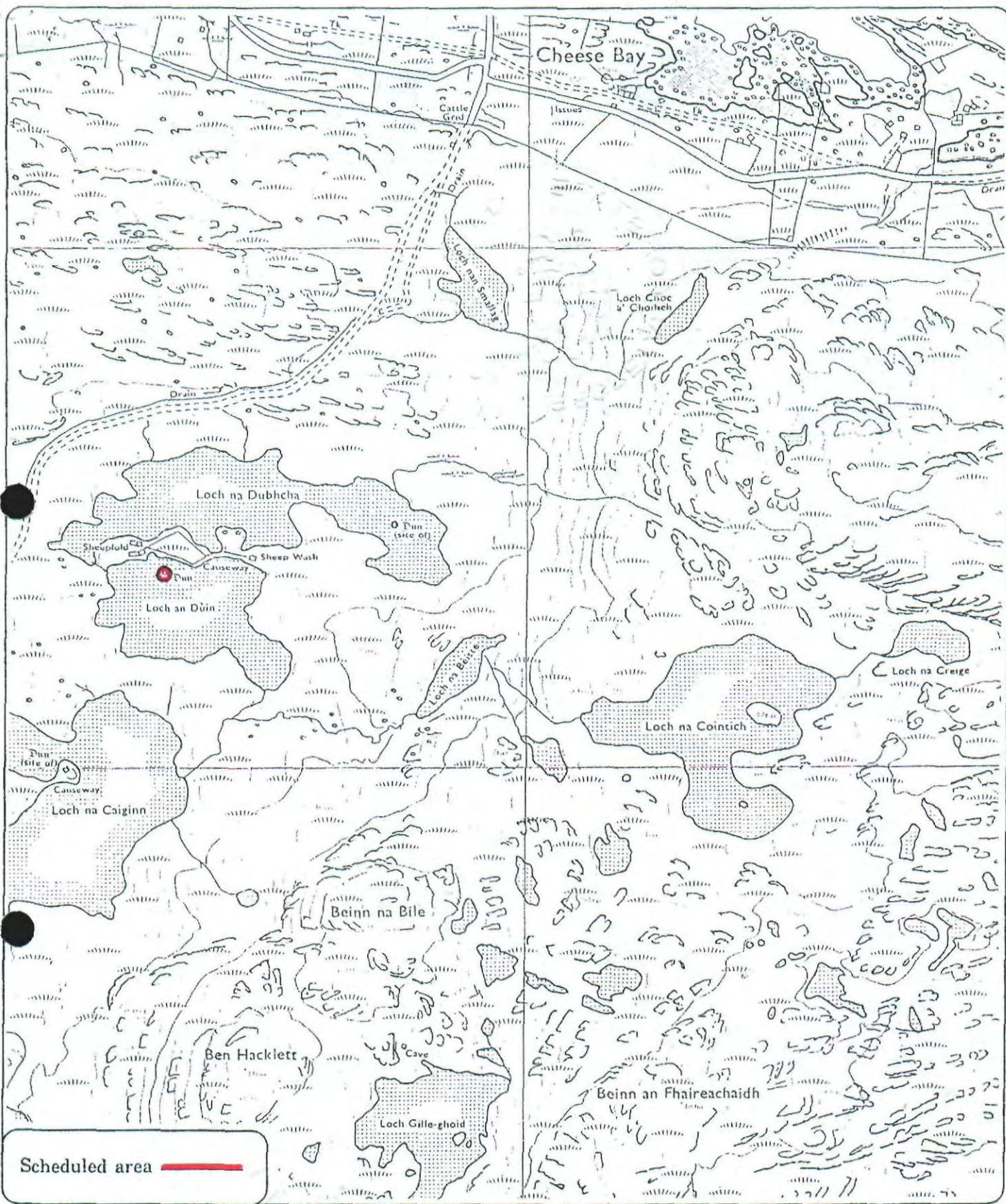

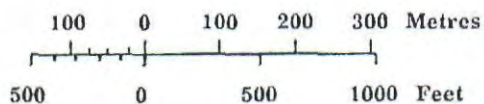
