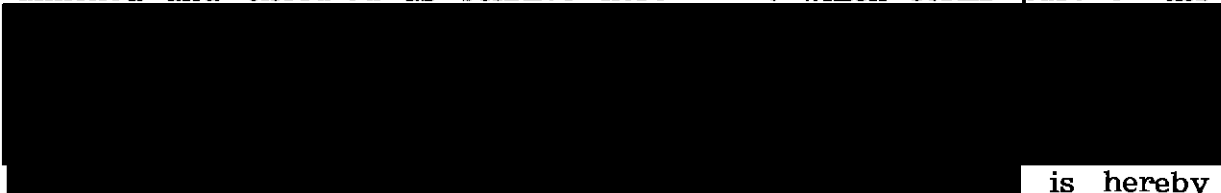

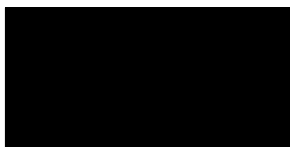

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Loch na Caiginn, dun and settlement comprises a late prehistoric fortified island with an overlying medieval settlement situated on an island in Loch na Caiginn, linked to the loch shore by a substantial causeway. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, measuring a maximum of 100m NE-SW by 65m NW-SE, to include the dun, settlement, causeway and an area around them (including a portion of the bed of the loch) in which further structural remains or archaeological deposits may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

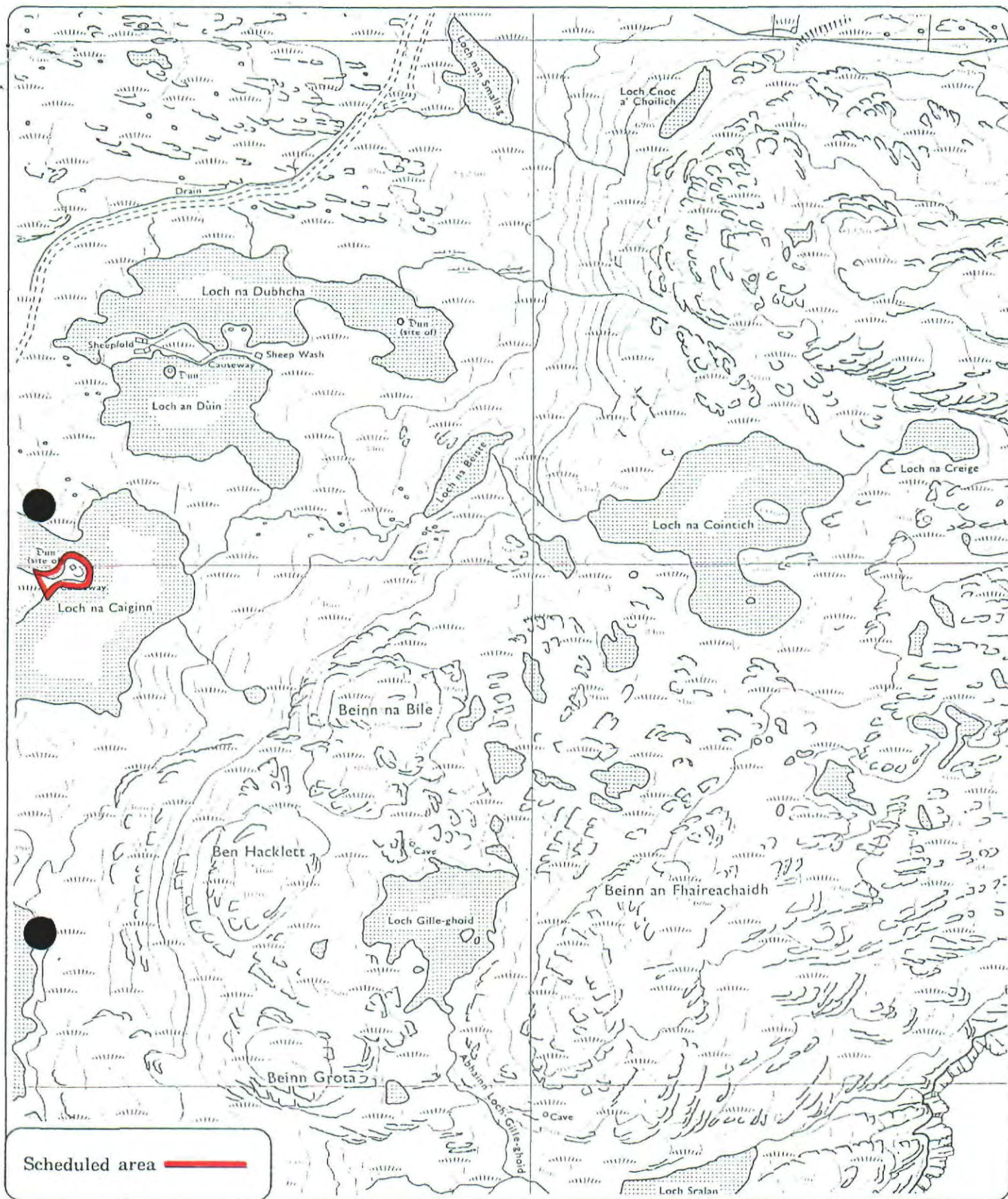

Scheduled area

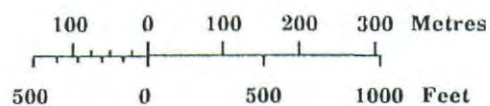
Loch na Caiginn, dun and
