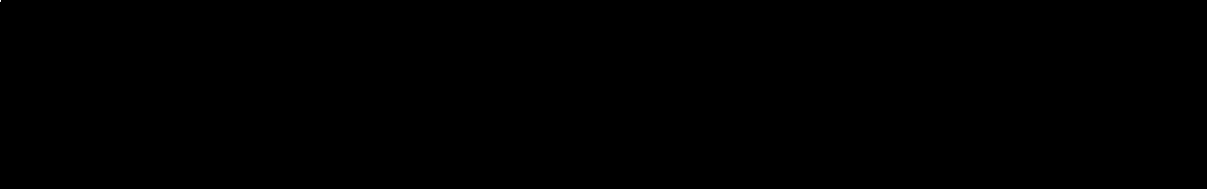

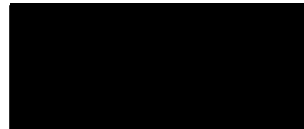
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Loch Sgardam, burial chamber, Breasclete comprises a setting of boulders which may represent the chamber of an uncompleted or otherwise removed prehistoric chambered burial cairn. The area to be scheduled is a 30m square, oriented N-S, with its SW corner just inside a fenceline, to include the stone setting and an area around in which evidence relating to its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Uig and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

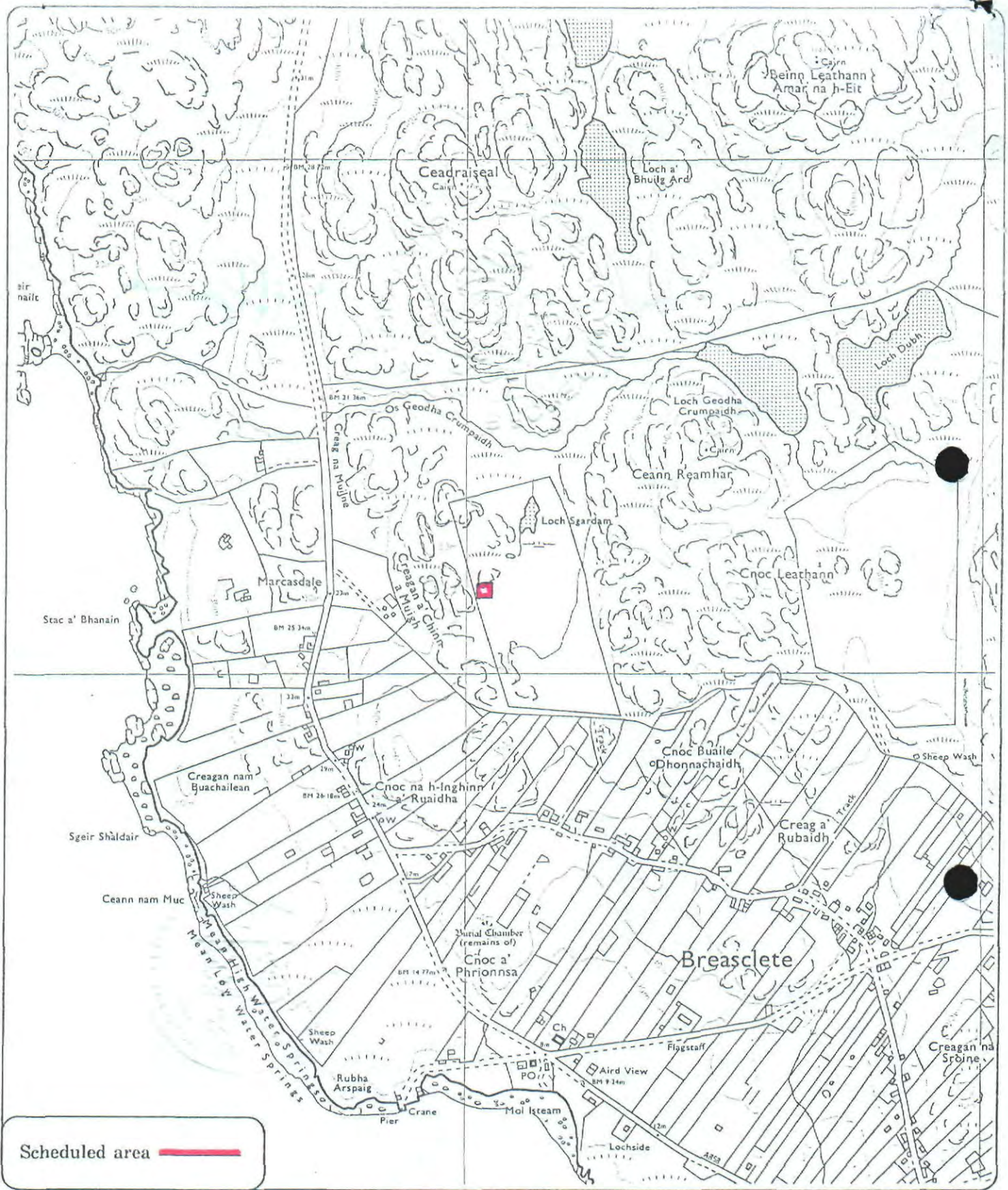

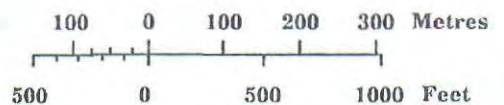
