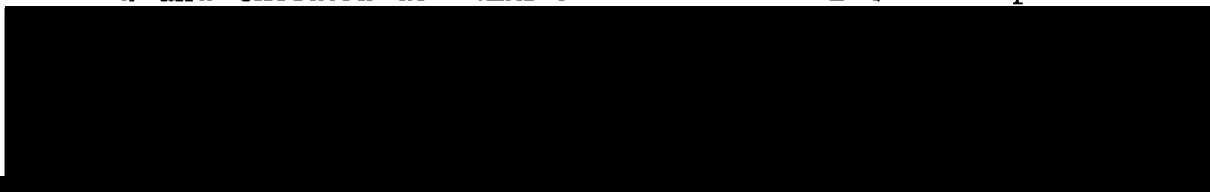

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as South Clettraval, chambered cairns, standing stone and aisled house comprises two chambered burial cairns, one with a secondary Iron Age aisled house constructed into it, and a standing stone lying between the two cairns. The area to be scheduled is in two parts: a 100m square, aligned N-S, containing the SE cairn and an area around it, and a triangle with N side of 200m, E side of 235m and SW side of 310m containing the NW cairn, the aisled house and outbuildings and the standing stone, together with an area around them in which further remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

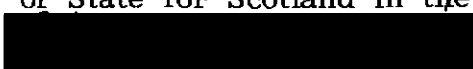

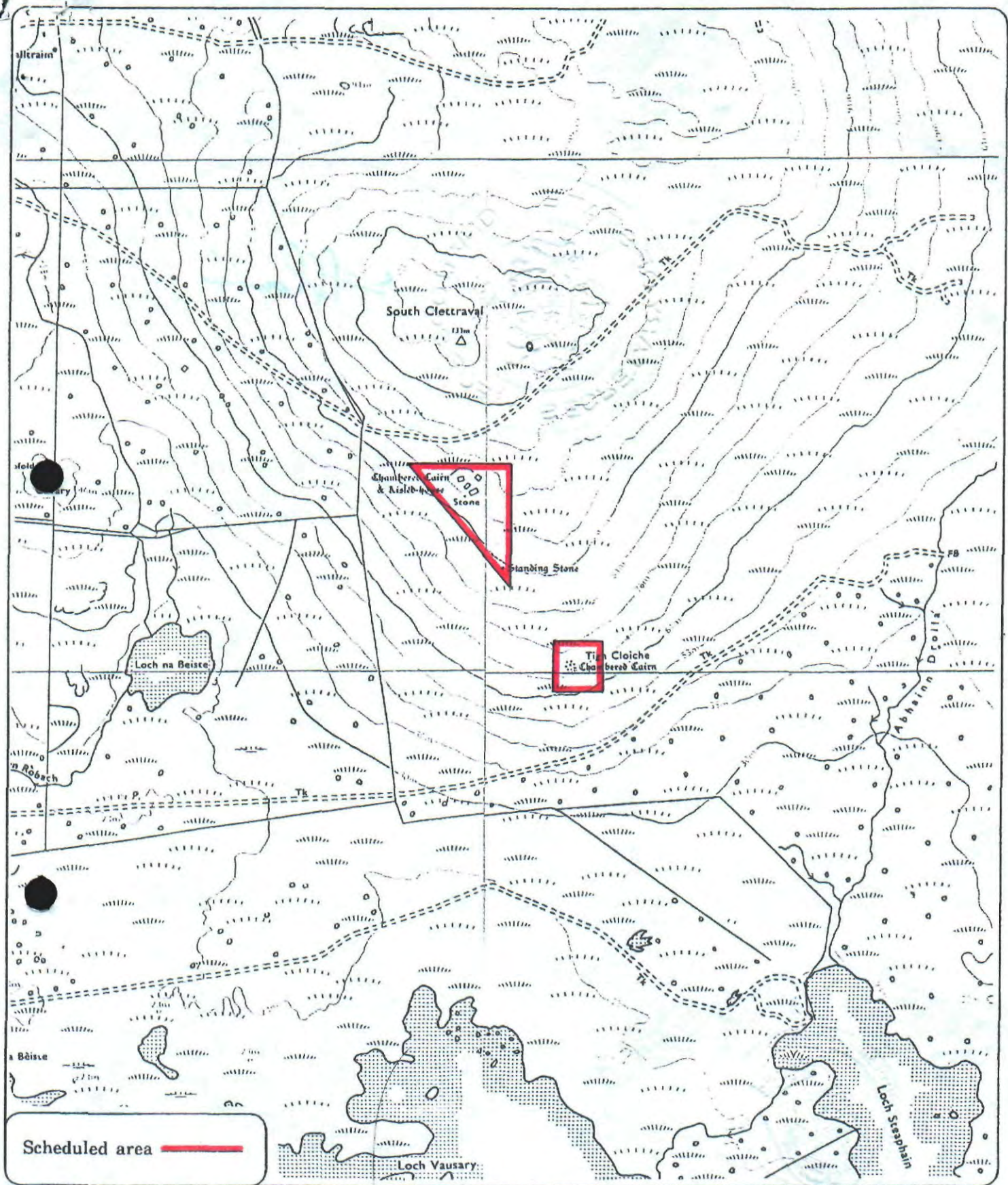

house

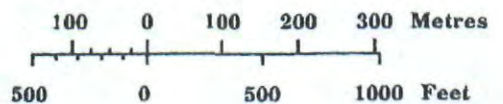
