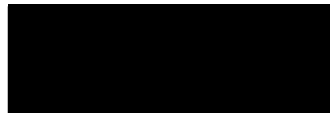

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Prestwick, Old Parish Church comprises the ruins of a simple parish church dedicated to St Nicholas. The structure probably dates from the twelfth or thirteenth century but has been greatly modified in the eighteenth century. The area to be scheduled is rectangular and includes the standing walls, the area within and an area extending 2m beyond the exterior face of the walls, measuring a maximum of 18.5m E-W by 11.05m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Monkton and Prestwick and the County of Ayr as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
