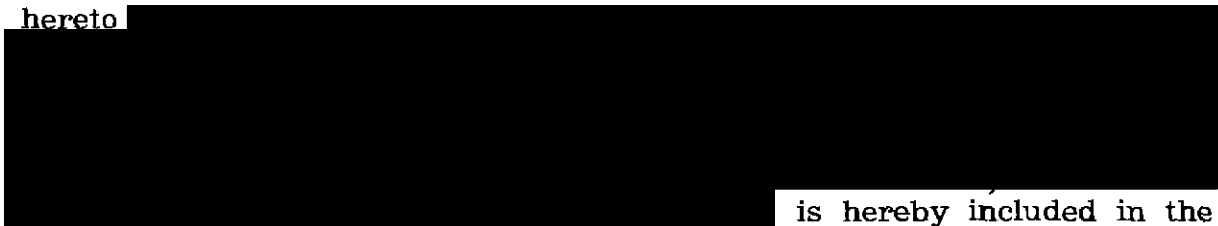

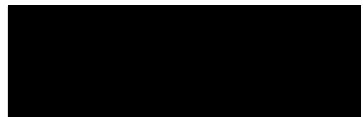
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Clach Stei Lin, stone circle and enclosure comprises of a standing stone and several fallen stones, the remains of a stone setting, and an enclosure, possibly of later date. The area to be scheduled is a circle 80m in diameter to include the standing stone and the fallen stones of the circle and the enclosure, together with an area around them in which additional remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Barvas and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Scheduled area

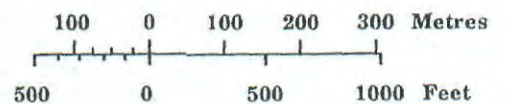
