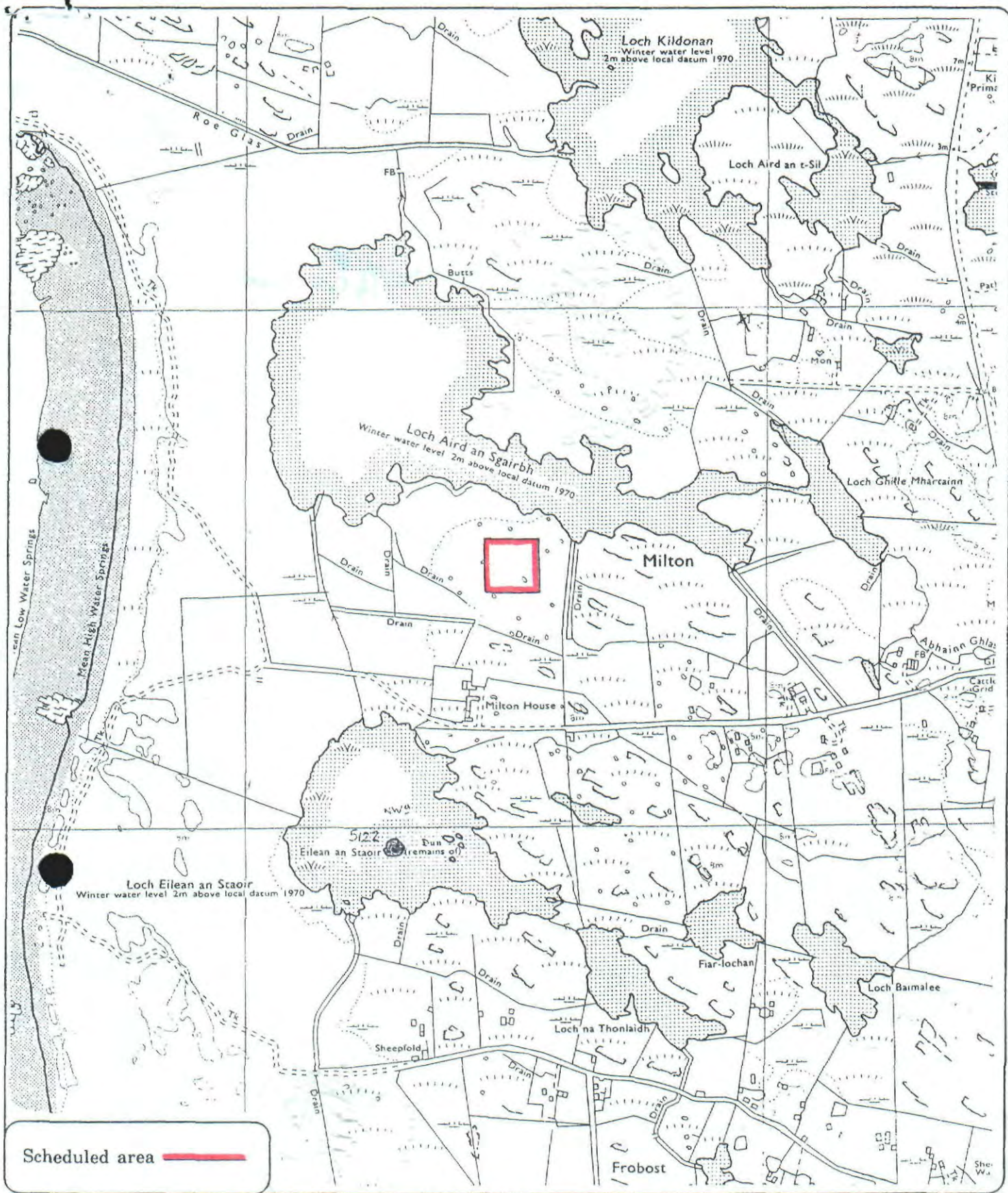

Scheduled area

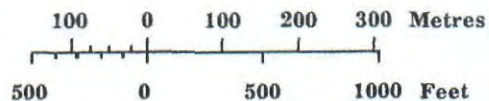
