ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Marykirk, old parish church and burial ground comprises the remains of the old parish church of Marykirk, formerly Abirlothenot, contained within an oval cemetery surrounded by a wall. The area to be scheduled includes the buried and standing remains of the old parish church, the burial aisles and the graveyard and graveyard wall enclosing them, an oval measuring some 50m E-W by 40m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Marykirk and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

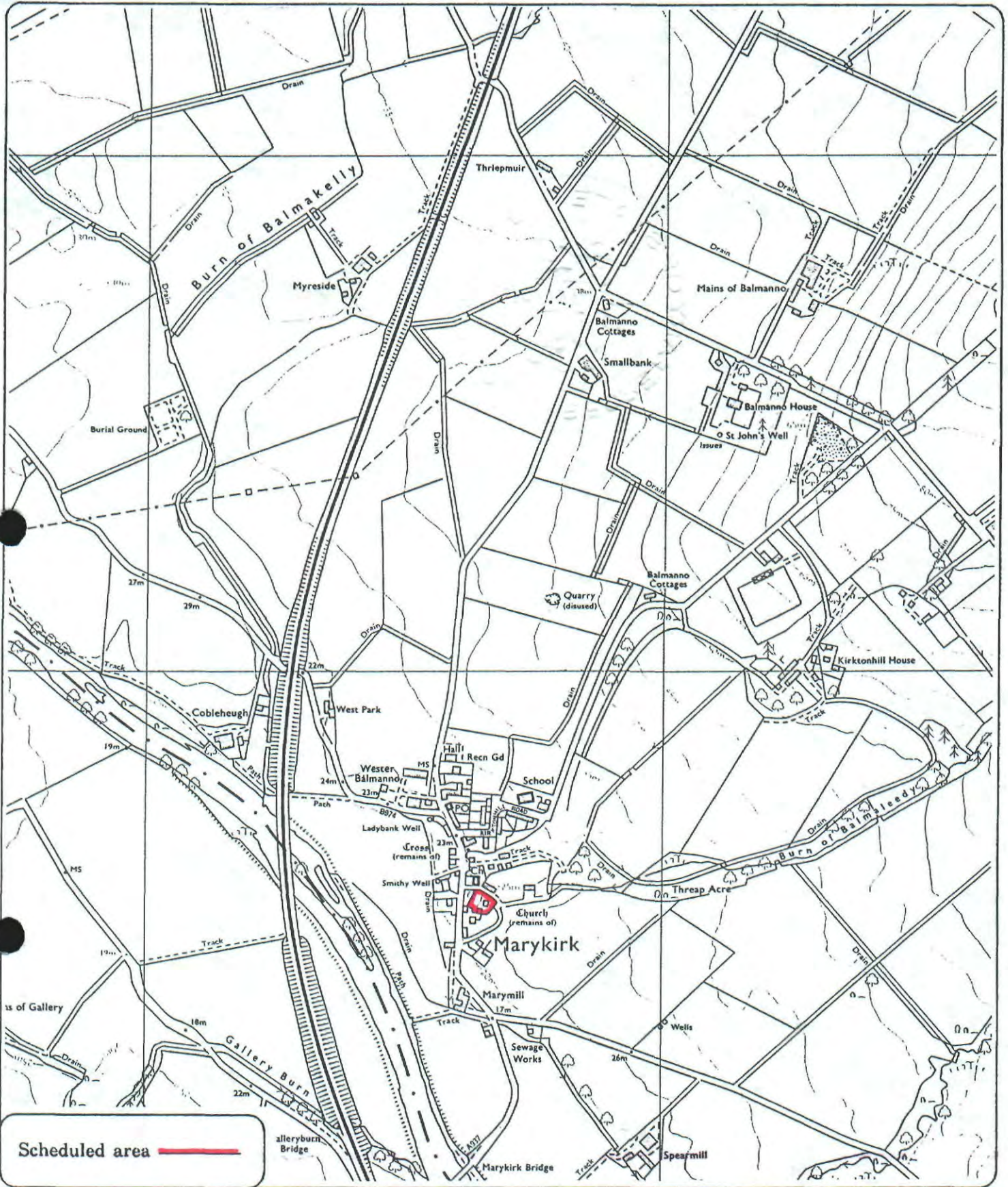

Scheduled area

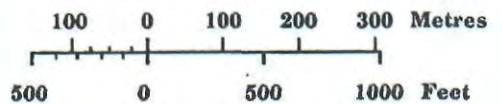
Marykirk, old parish church and burial ground
