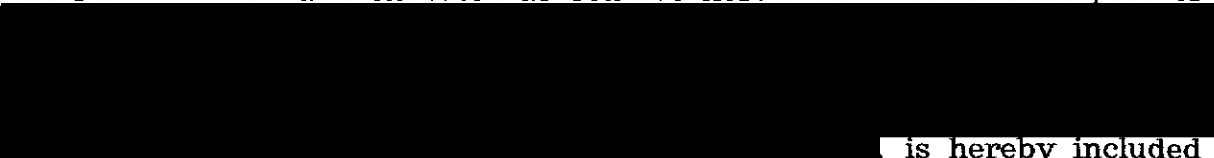

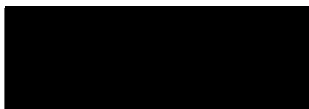
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Stackel Brae, castle, Maltbarn, Eday comprises the remains of a small fortified dwelling and other structures, probably dating to the period of Norse rule in Orkney. The area to be scheduled is irregular, bounded by the foot of the low eroding cliff on the S. On the W it is bounded by a line drawn parallel to, and 10m E of, the easternmost building of the farm of Maltbarn. The area has maximum dimensions 85m SW-NE by 40m NNW-SSE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Eday and the County of Orkney as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

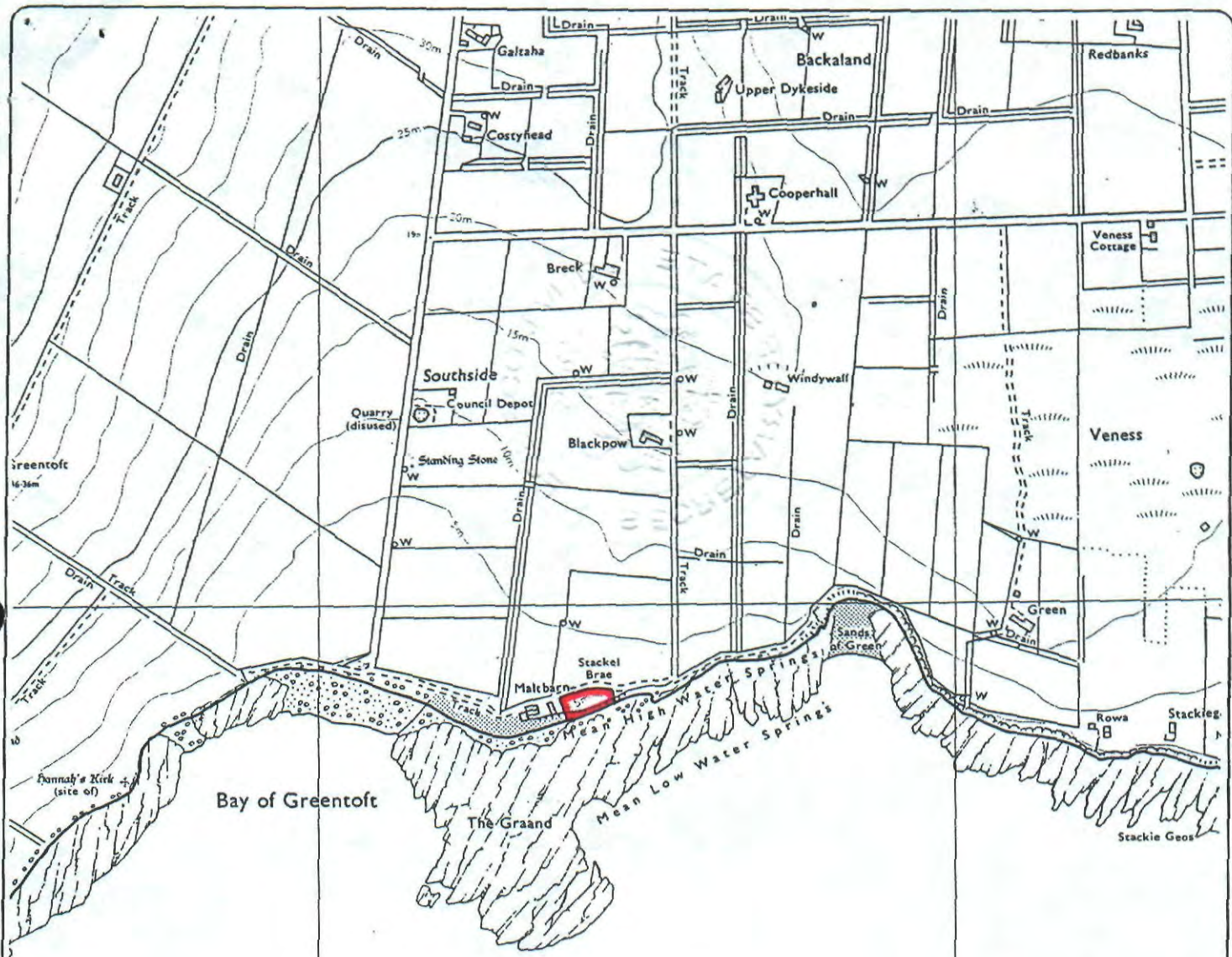

Scheduled area

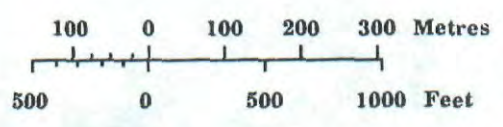
