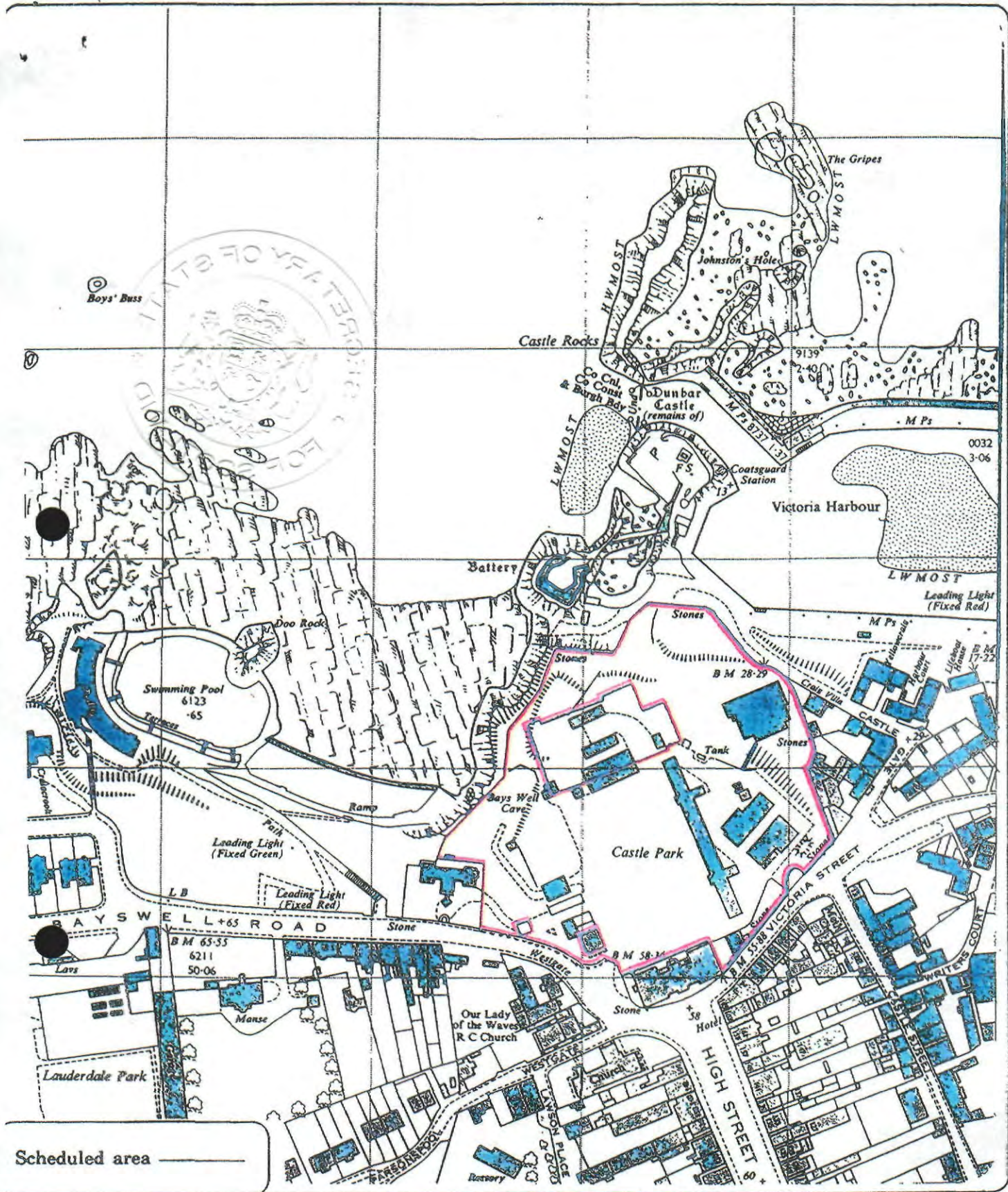

Scheduled area ———

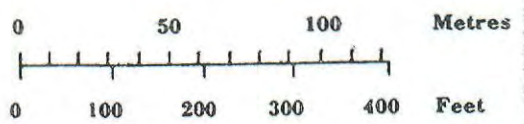
