The monument known as Airidh nam Bidearan, standing stones N of comprises a group of standing stones, perhaps the remains of a prehistoric stone circle or setting. The area to be scheduled is a square of side 100m, aligned N-S, to include all five stones and an area around them, particularly to the E, in which further fallen stones and other remains may lie concealed. 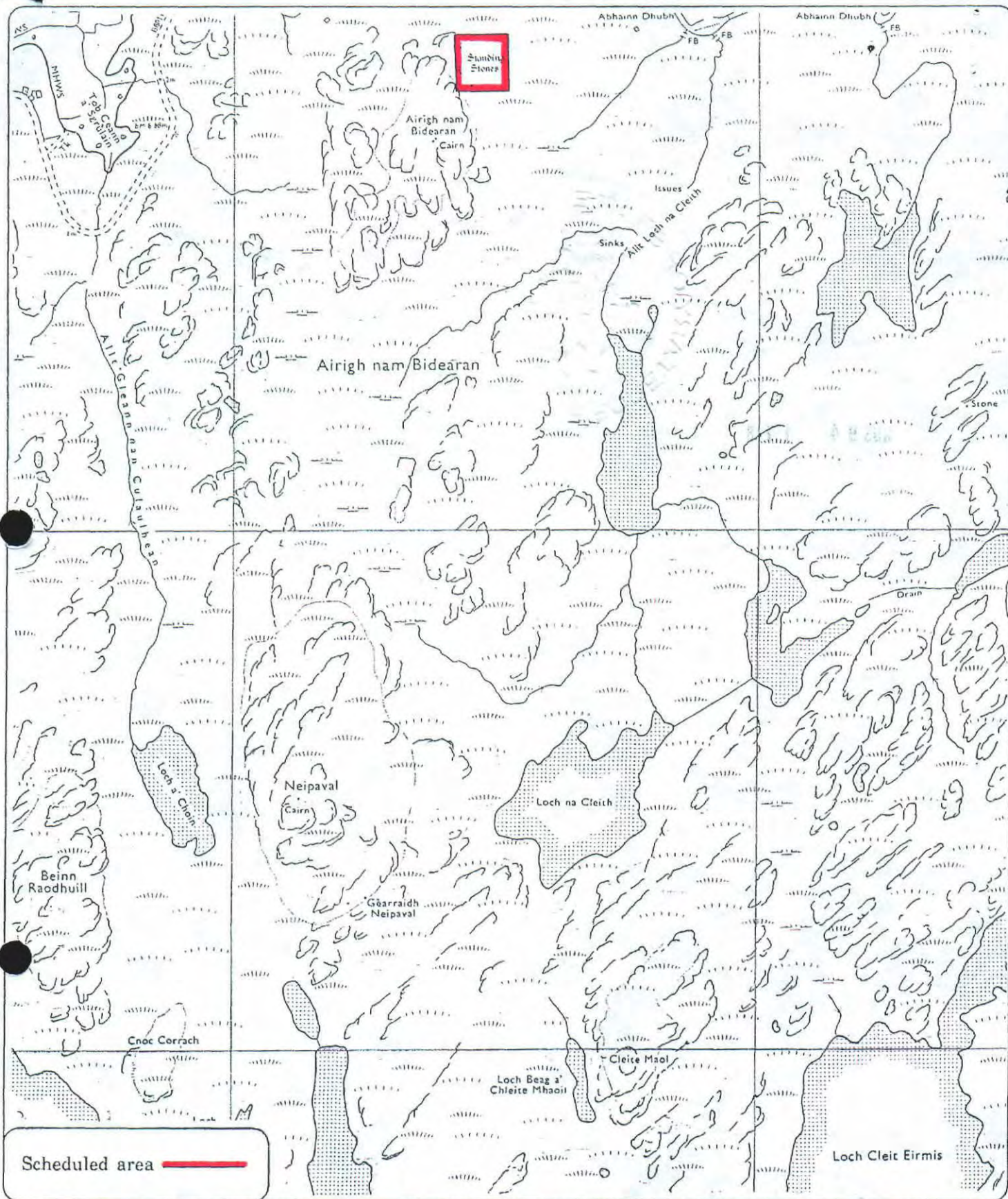
