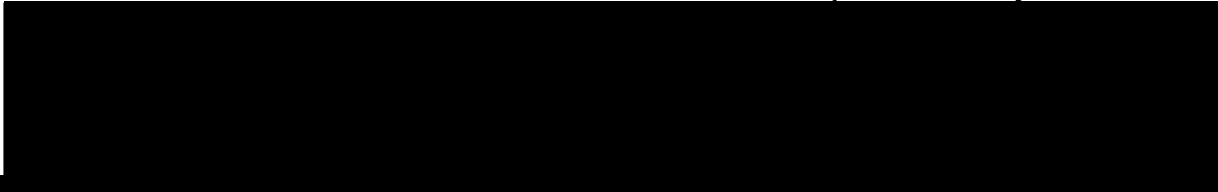

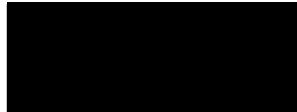
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Penshiel Grange comprises the remains of a monastic grange known as Penshiel. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 90m E-W by 120m N-S. Existing modern fences are excluded from scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Whittingehame and the County of East Lothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

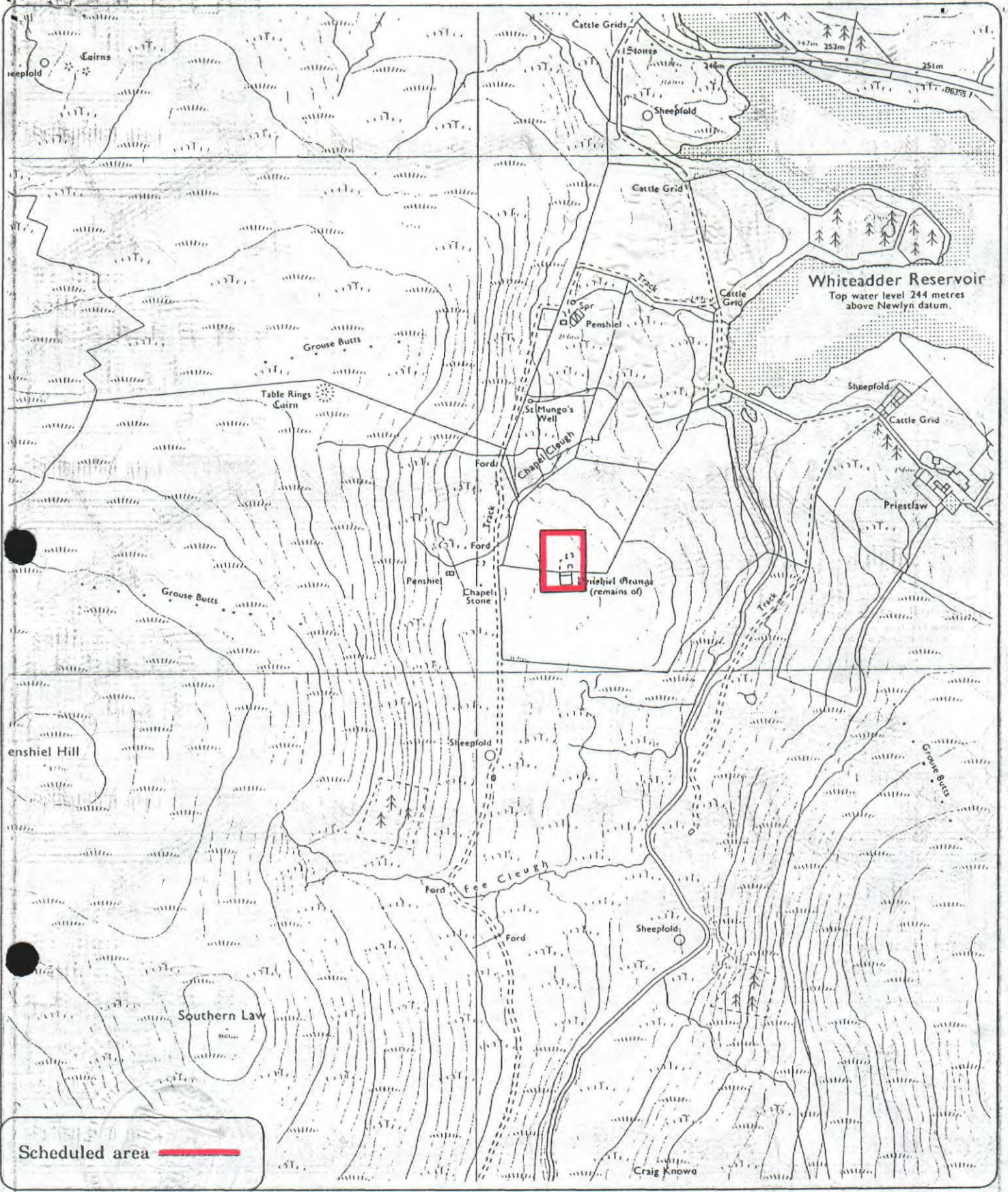
