

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 6057
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as **1 Ironshill Farm Cottages, settlements, barrow and pits 250m SSW of** comprises the remains of enclosed and unenclosed settlements dating to between 1800 BC and AD 400. It also includes pits and a probable barrow potentially of earlier date. The settlements and other features lie buried beneath the ploughsoil and are visible as cropmarks captured on oblique aerial photographs. The monument lies at about 25m above OD on relatively flat, slightly elevated farmland S of the Lunan Water. The scheduled area is irregular on plan to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive. The scheduling specifically excludes the above-ground elements of a post-and-wire fence that crosses the area from NNW to SSE to allow for its maintenance. At the E end of the S side, the scheduled area extends up to but excludes a post-and-wire fence aligned ENE-WSW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inverkeilor and the County of Angus as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Ironshill, palisaded homesteads, enclosures and ring ditches S of** as referred to in the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments by the Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 7 July 1994 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Angus on 20 July 1994.

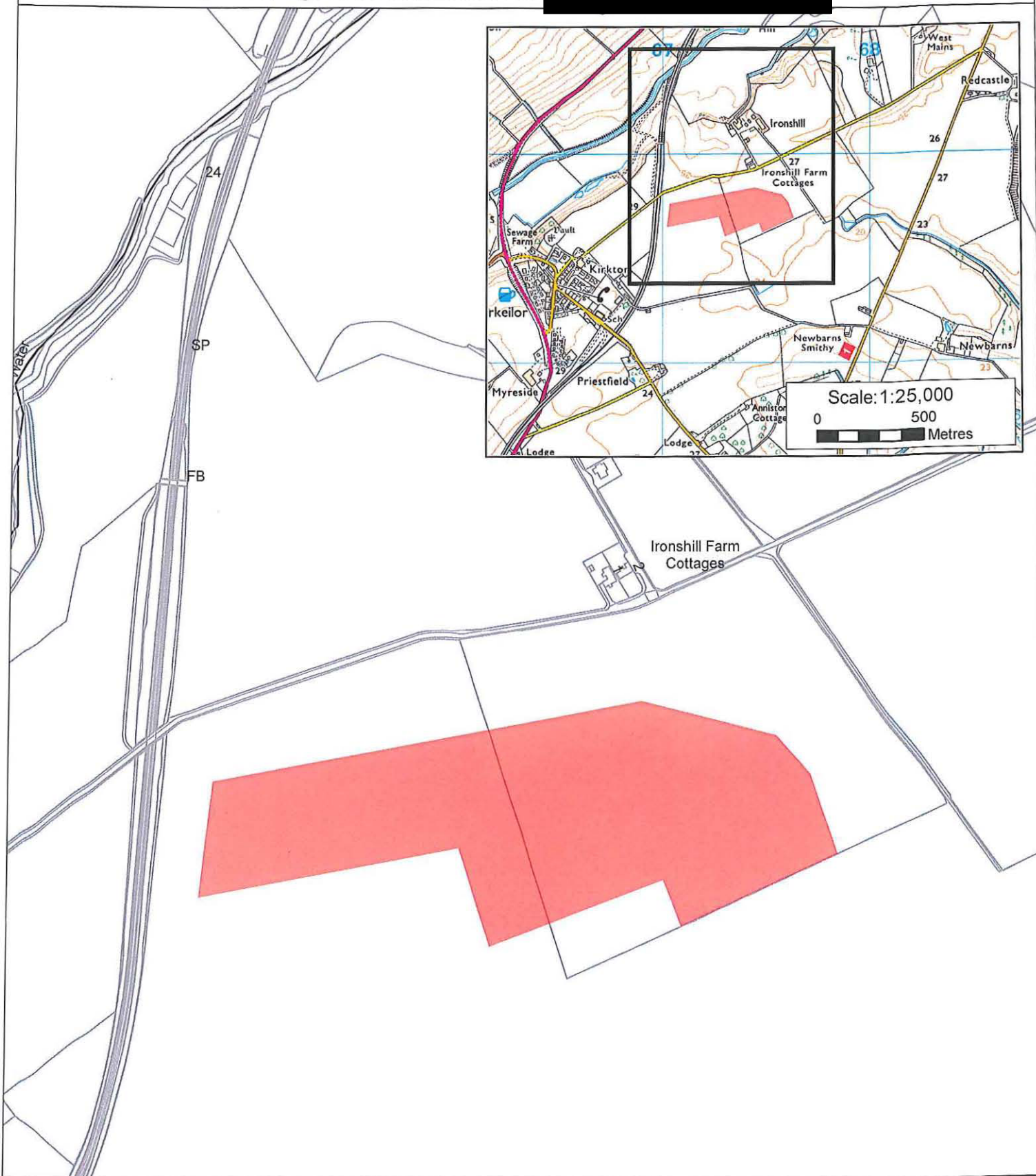
