ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Vidlin, broch at W end of Ayre of Vidlin, comprises the remains of a broch, an Iron Age fortified dwelling. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is irregular and bounded on the W by the outer face of the church and the boundary of its access track. On the N, NE, E and SE it is bounded by the access track and car park for the nearby marina. The road, car park and lay-bys are all excluded from the scheduled area. It has maximum dimensions of 41m NNE-SSW by 24m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Nesting and the Counties of Orkney and Zetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

Scheduled Area



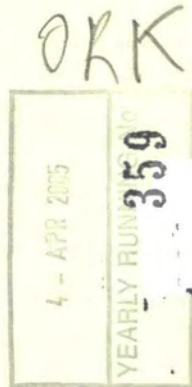
