

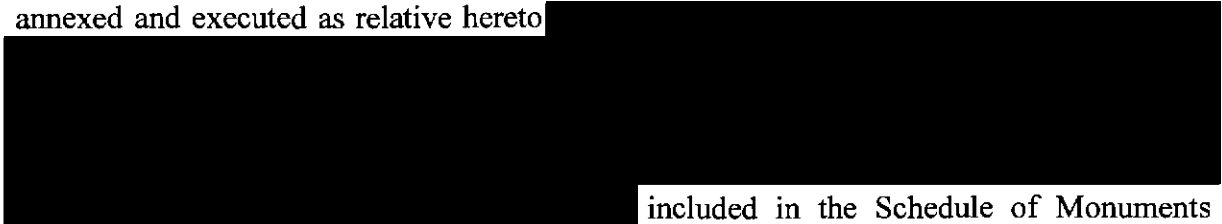

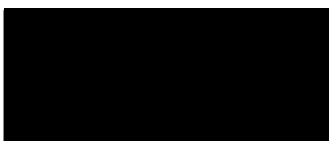
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Springhill, standing stone 500m NNW of comprises a prehistoric standing stone. It is situated on the top of a ridge in an arable field. The area to be scheduled measures 40m in diameter centred on the standing stone to include the original standing stone and an area around it in which the location of the second standing stone and further remains associated with their erection and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Skene and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

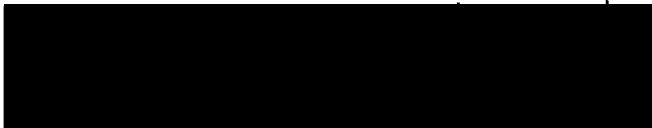

Scheduled area —

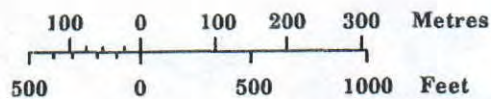
Springhill, standing stone 500m
