THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Ballochan, hut circles 350m ENE of comprises three hut circles and a group of clearance cairns, probably of the later prehistoric period, situated close to the N bank of the Water of Feugh. The area to be scheduled, which contains the hut circles, the clearance cairns and may contain further features associated with their construction and use, is split into two parts by a modern track, which, with the fence bounding it on the west, is excluded from scheduling. The western area measures a maximum of 120m NW to SE by a maximum of 60m transversely, bounded on the NE and SE by tracks (which are excluded); the eastern area measures a maximum of 100m NW to SE, by a maximum of 50m transversely, bounded by tracks (which are excluded from the scheduling) on the NW and NE sides. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Birse and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms

included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

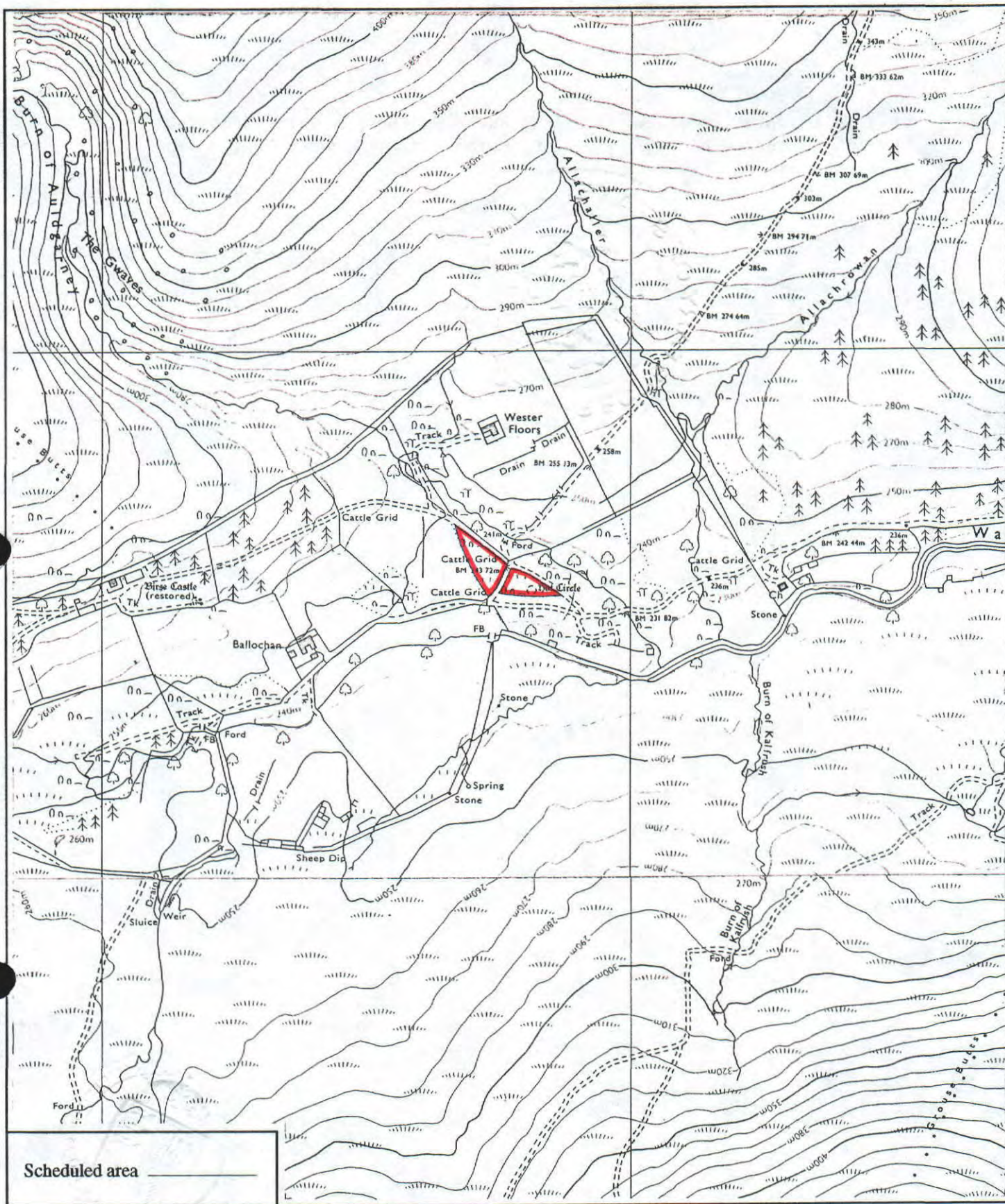

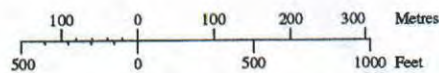
Ballochran, hut circles 350m ENE of
