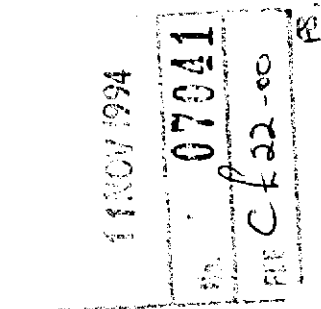

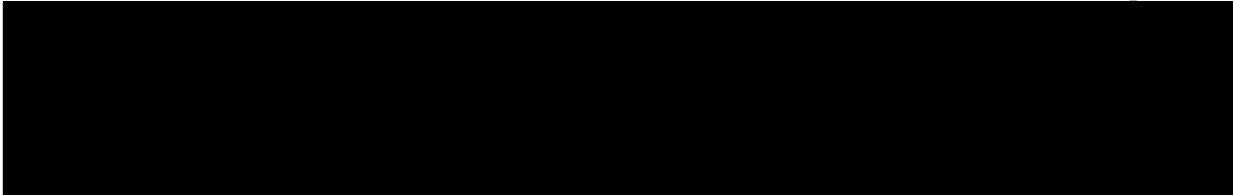

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cairnshee, enclosure 440m SW of comprises a circular enclosure of the mid to late prehistoric period. It is situated on a knoll on a low hill. The area to be scheduled is roughly triangular, bounded by a recent track on the S and recent field boundaries on the N and E, to include the enclosure and ruined wall and an area around them in which further remains associated with their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Durris and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of
