

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 6097
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as **Langleypark, enclosure and barrow 290m N of Gilrivie** comprises the remains of a multivallate enclosure dating to before AD 400 and a cluster of nearby features, including a barrow. The remains lie buried beneath the ploughsoil and are visible as cropmarks captured on oblique aerial photographs. The monument lies at about 15m OD on relatively flat arable farmland about 750m N of the shore of the Montrose Basin. The scheduled area is irregular on plan to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dun and the County of Angus as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects registered in the Land Register of Scotland under Title No ANG51079 [REDACTED]

[REDACTED], is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Gilrivie, enclosure and barrow 300m N of** as referred to in the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments by the Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 10 October 1994 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Angus on 11 November 1994.

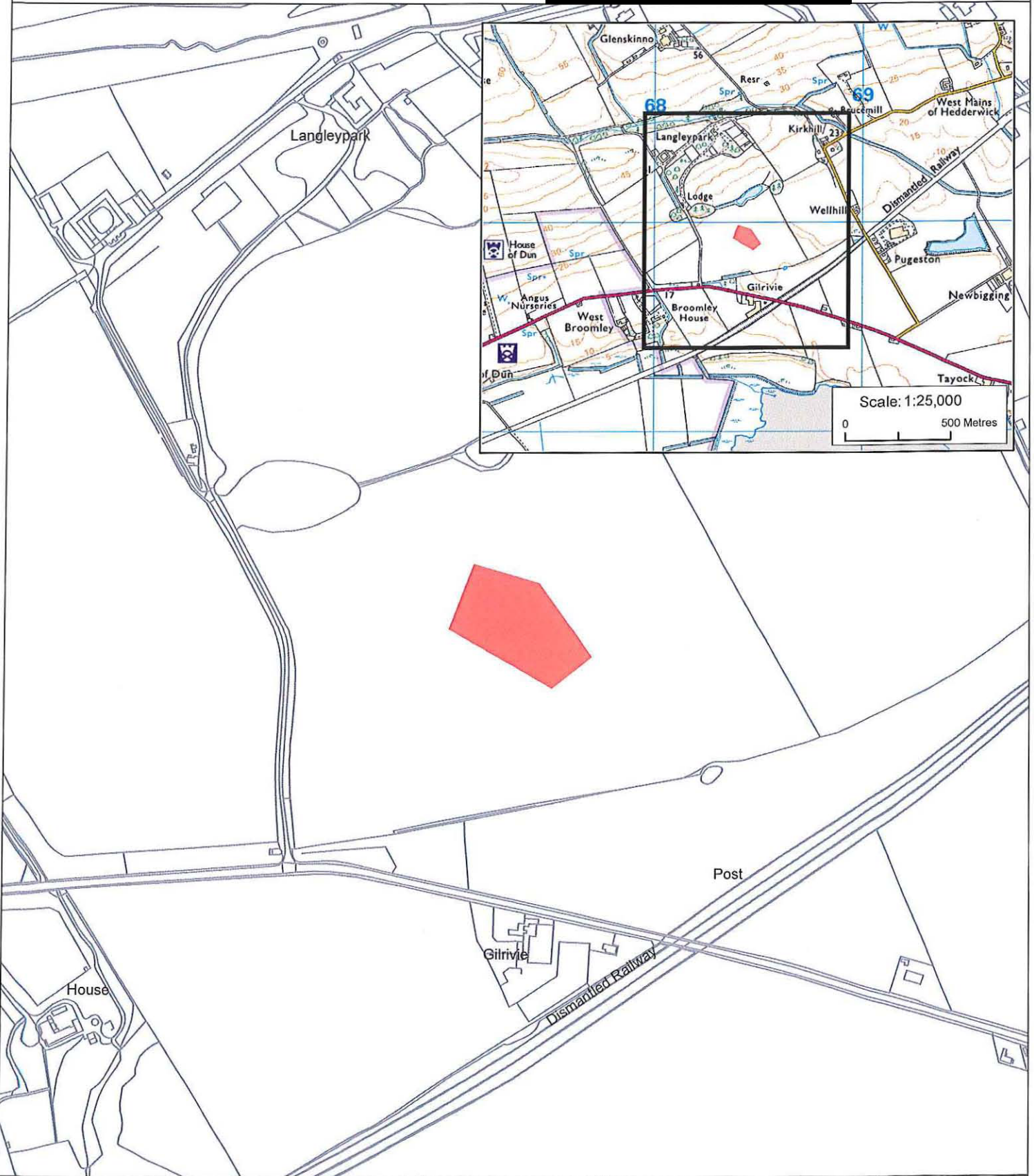
