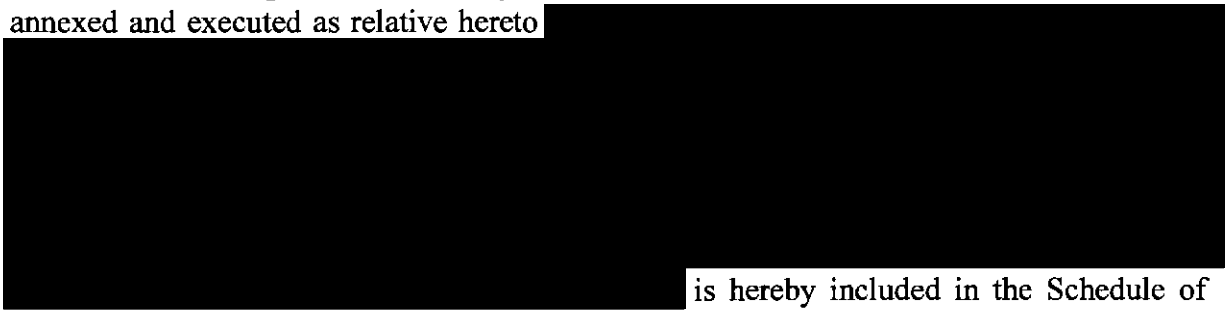

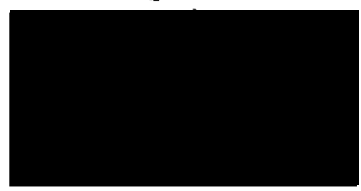

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Pitsligo Castle comprises a large roofless courtyard castle of 15th- to 18th-century date, with an extensive walled garden to N and an enclosed area of woodland to S. The area to be scheduled is approximately rectangular, measuring some 150m E-W by 130m N-S and including all boundary walls. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Pitsligo and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

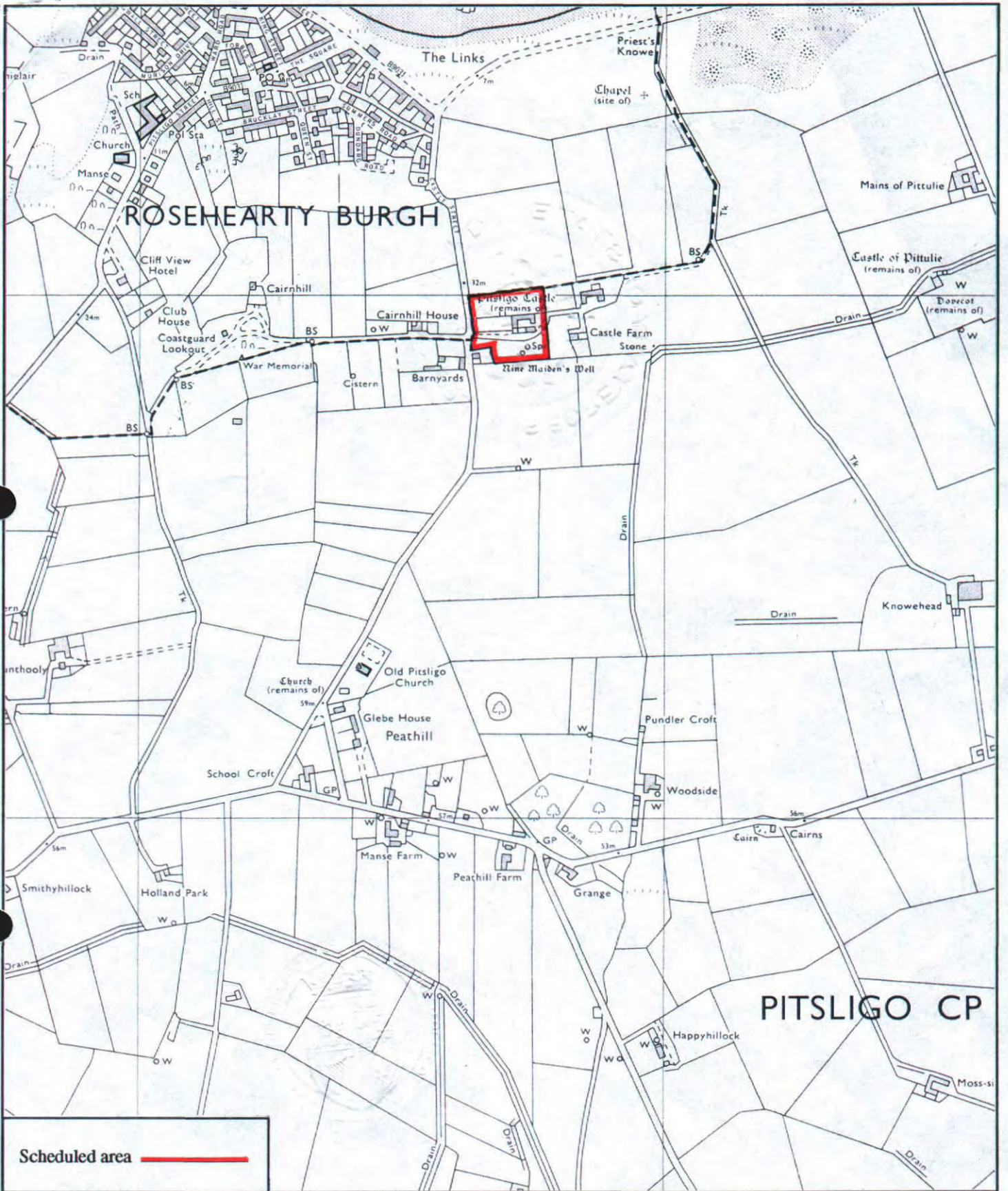

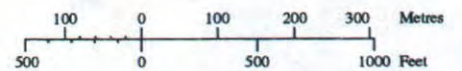
Pitsligo Castle
