


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 6218
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as **West Mains, enclosure and souterrains 265m NNE of** comprises the remains of an enclosure expected to date to between 1400 BC and AD 400 and a probable souterrain abandoned by AD 400. The enclosure and souterrain lie buried beneath the ploughsoil. The enclosure is visible as cropmarks captured on oblique aerial photographs; the probable souterrain has been identified by trial excavation. The monument lies at about 20m OD on gently sloping ground immediately S of the steep slope leading down to the Lunan Water. The scheduled area is irregular on plan to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inverkeilor and the County of Angus as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **West Mains, enclosure 200m NNE of** as referred to in the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments by the Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 21 August 1995 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Angus on 6 November 1995.

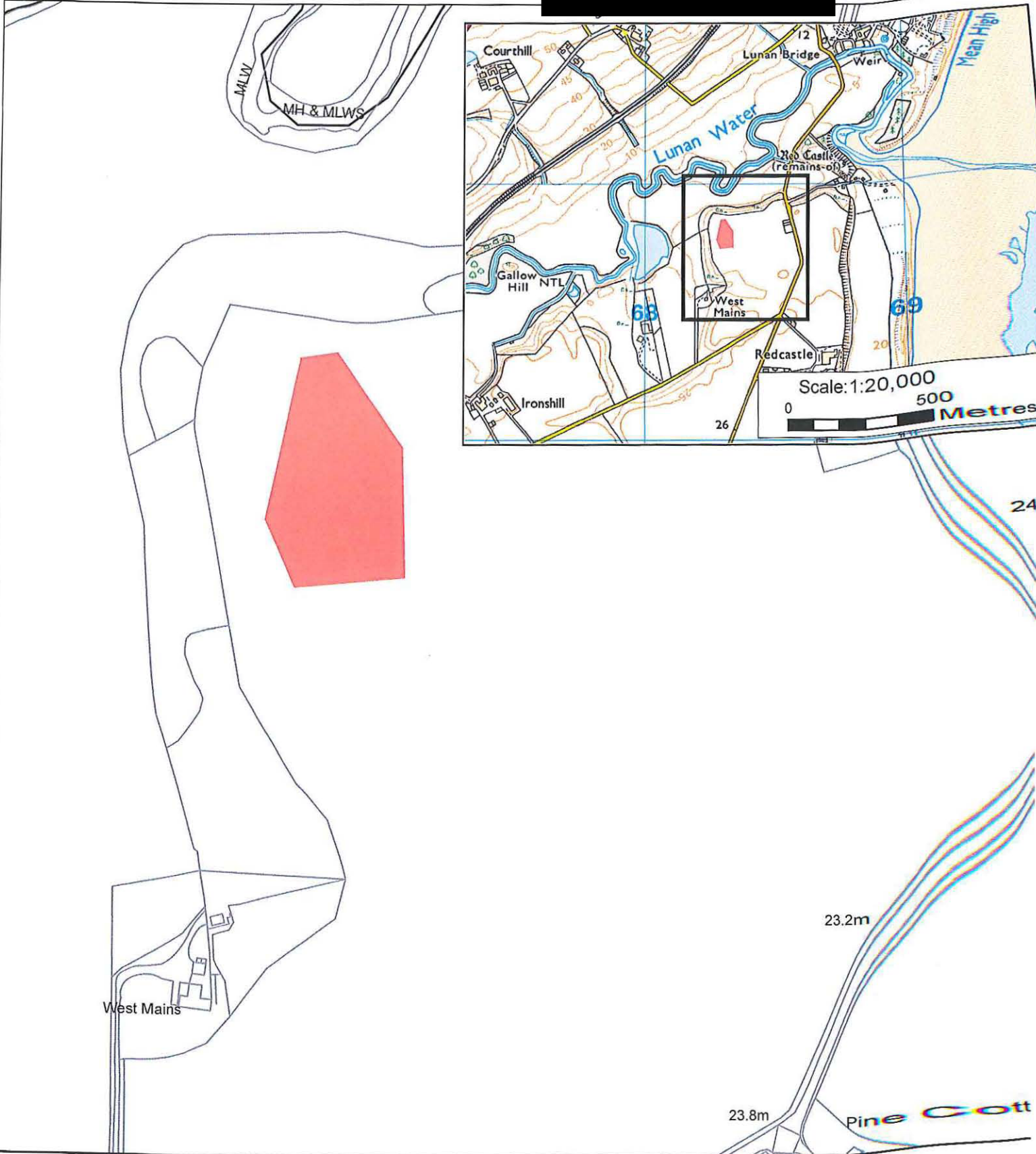
