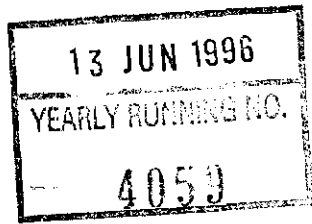

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Coroghon Castle, Canna comprises a fortified rock stack together with an area in which prehistoric midden material has been found. The area to be scheduled is irregular in shape, measuring approximately 85m NW-SE by a maximum of 25m SW-NE. It includes the top of the rock stack, extending 10m N of the foot of the stack along its N side to include the ramped foot of the access path and an area in which traces of activity associated with the construction and use of the fortification may survive; and extends to the NW to include an area in which prehistoric midden material has been discovered and other traces of prehistoric activity may survive. It excludes the above-ground structure of the modern telecommunications building and the surface of the track. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Small Isles (Canna) and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

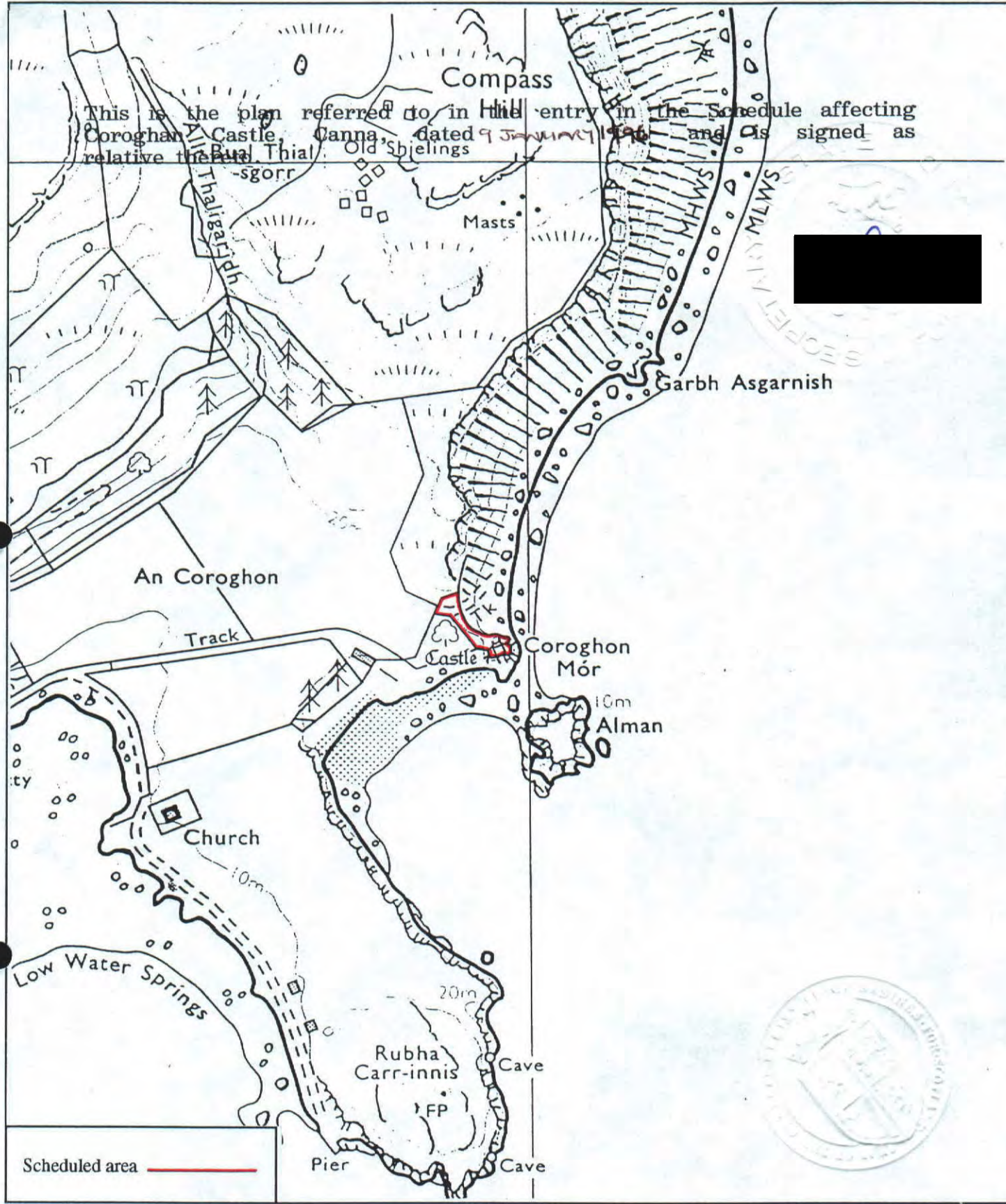

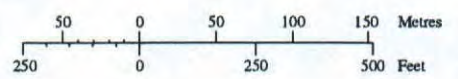
Coroghon Castle, Canna
