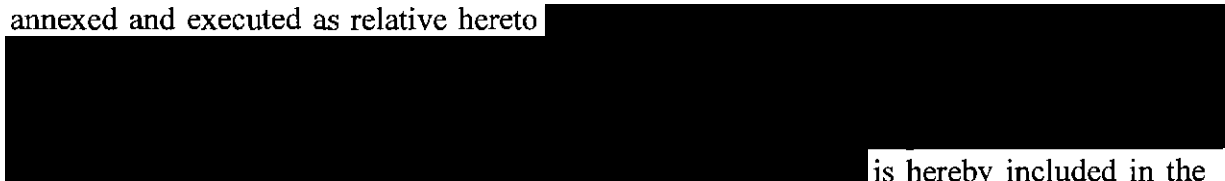

The monument known as Ballownie, mound 100m NE of comprises the remains of a burial mound of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the remains of the mound and an area around in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is a circle lacking parts of the W side, and has a diameter of 40m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Stracathro and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

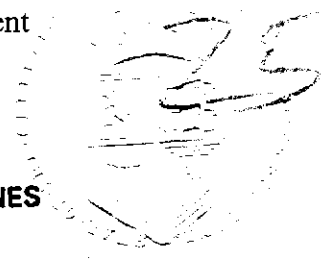

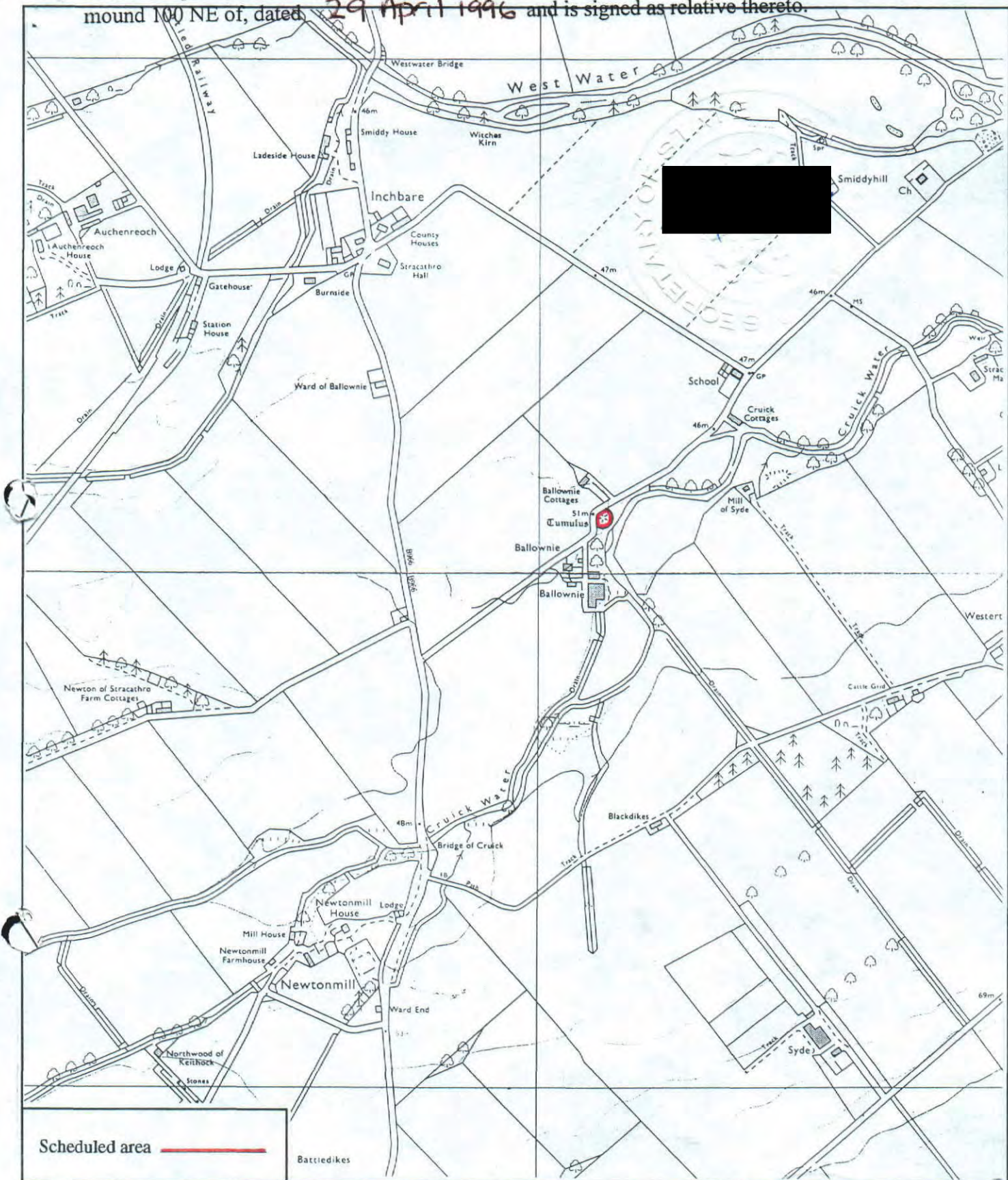
