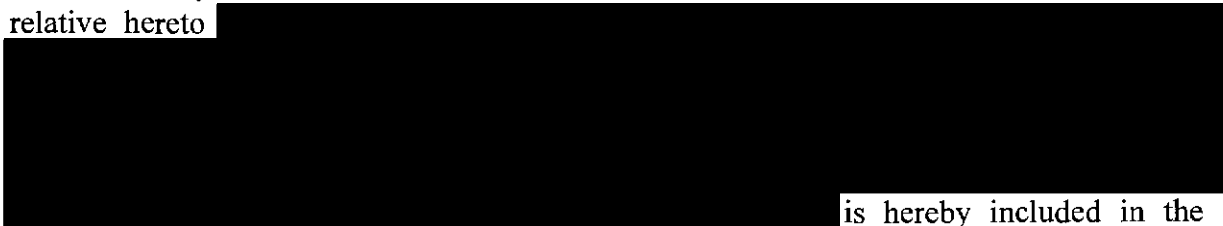

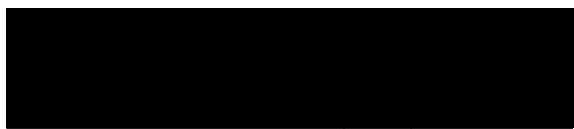
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Edingham Castle comprises the remains of a castle of early 16th century date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible remains and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is a square of side 30m aligned approximately NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Urr and the County of Dumfries as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

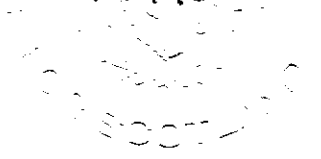

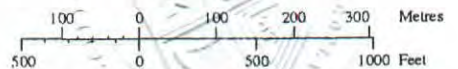
