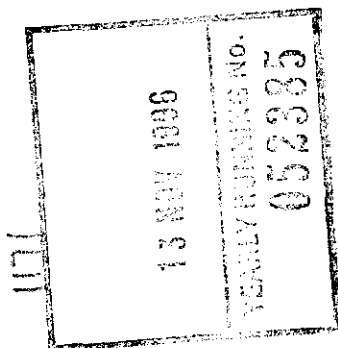




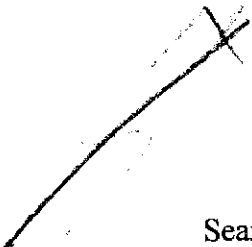

The monument known as Castlelaw Range, ring ditch NW of comprises the remains of a ring-ditch house of later prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible remains and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 50m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glencorse and the County of Midlothian as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

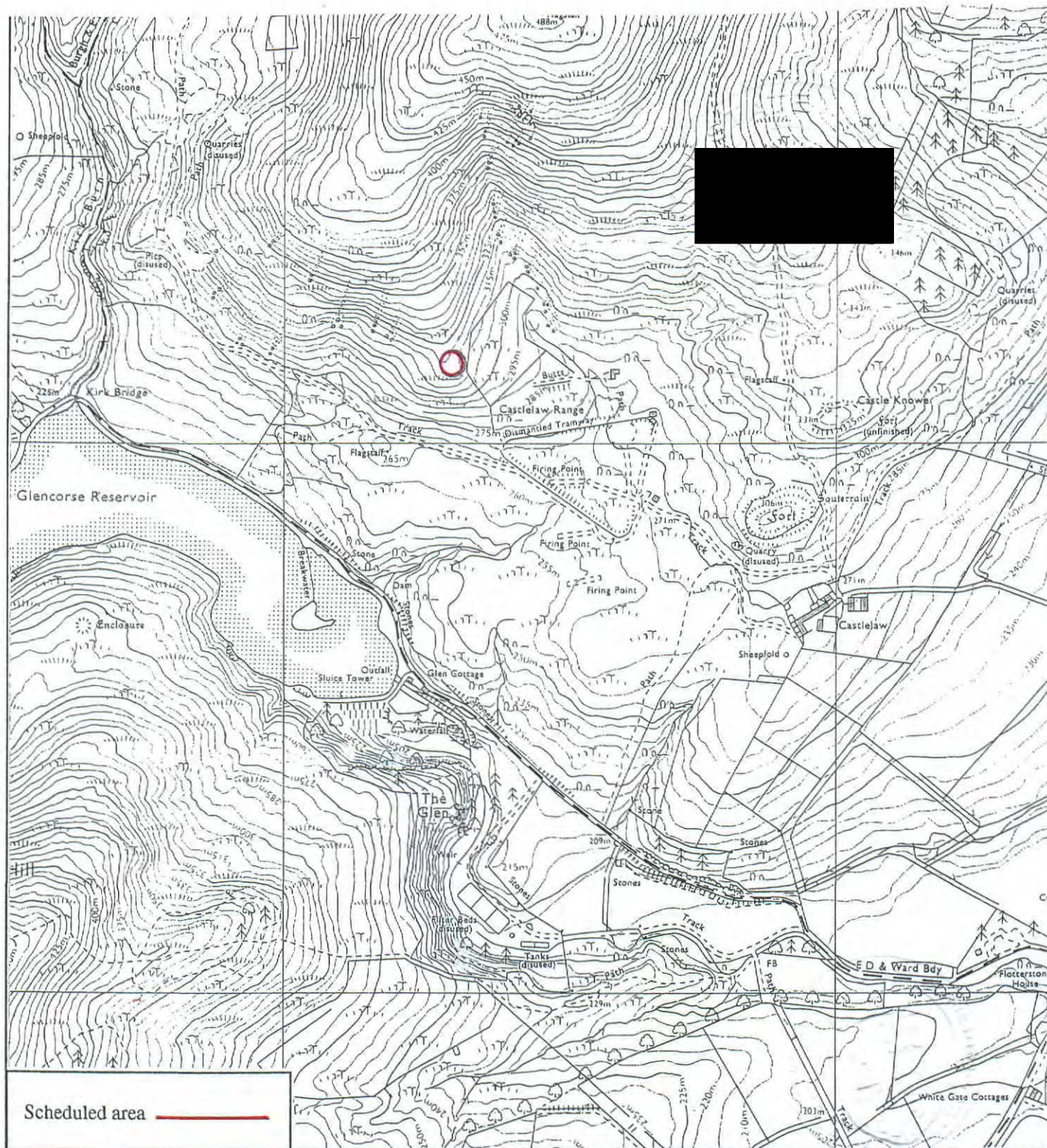

Scheduled area

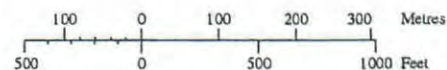
Castlelaw Range, ring ditch NW of
