The monument known as Crinan Canal, Loch a'Bharain, canal feeder comprises a basin, artificially embanked, and now occupied by a body of water, known as Loch a'Bharain, which forms a feeder reservoir for the Crinan Canal which lies immediately adjacent to its S. The area proposed to be scheduled includes all that part of the reservoir in water, the sluices and an area of ground around the feeder reservoir in which features associated with its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmichael Glassary and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]
