THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Innes Bhuidhe, forts, NE of Bridge of Dochart comprises the remains of two forts of prehistoric date surviving as a series of earthworks. The area to be scheduled encompasses the forts and an area around them in which traces of associated material may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape, bounded on the NW and SE by the island edge and on the NE by a low stone wall, which is itself excluded from scheduling. This area has maximum dimensions of 160m NE-SW by 50m NW-SE. The walled burial ground, the area around it and all of the ground to the NE of the low wall mentioned above are excluded. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Killin and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

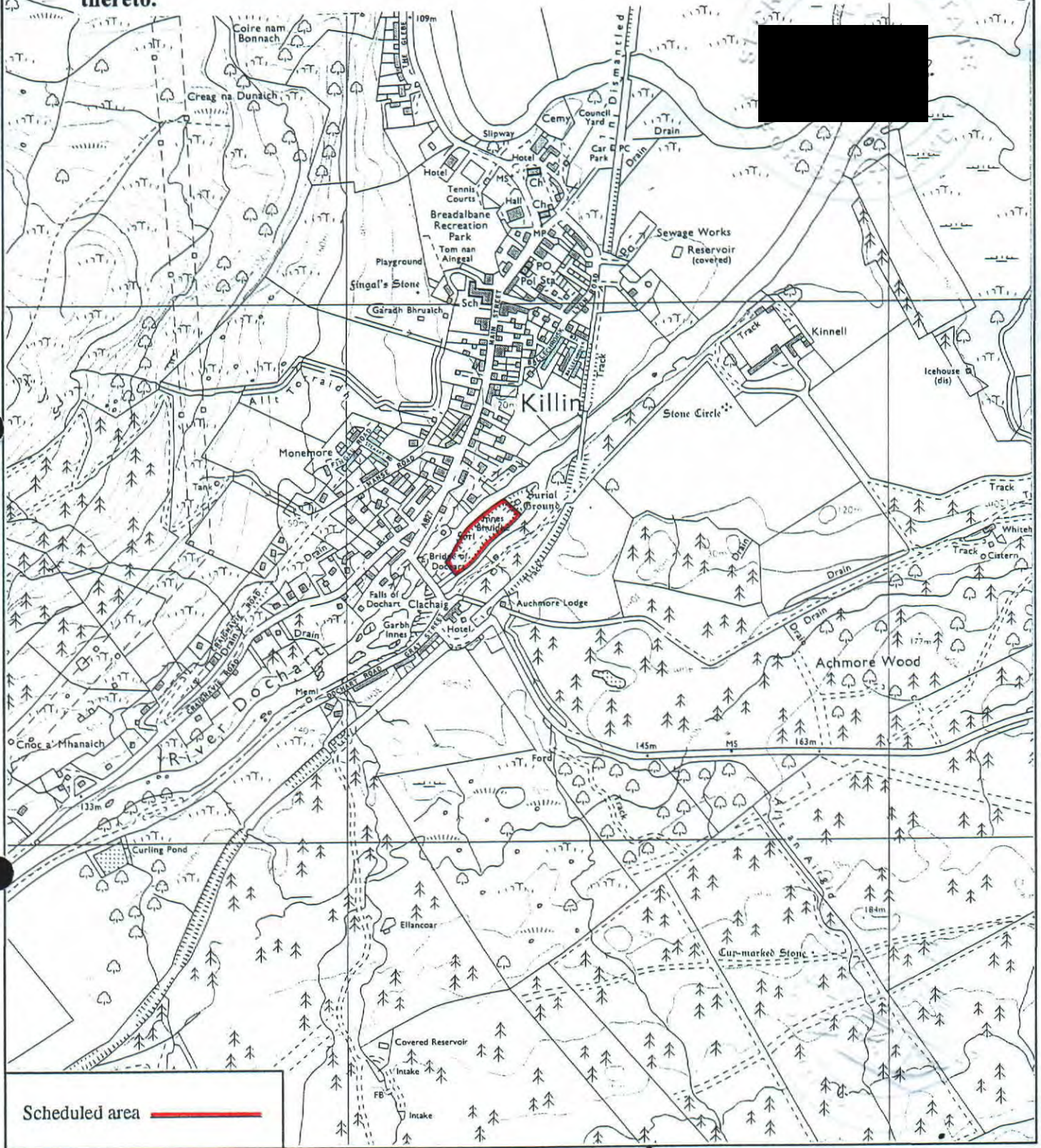

Scheduled area

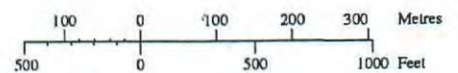
Innes Bhuidhe, forts, NE of Bridge of Dochart
