The monument known as Barry Hill, ring fort comprises the remains of a ring fort of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible remains of the ring fort and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 60m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Alyth and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

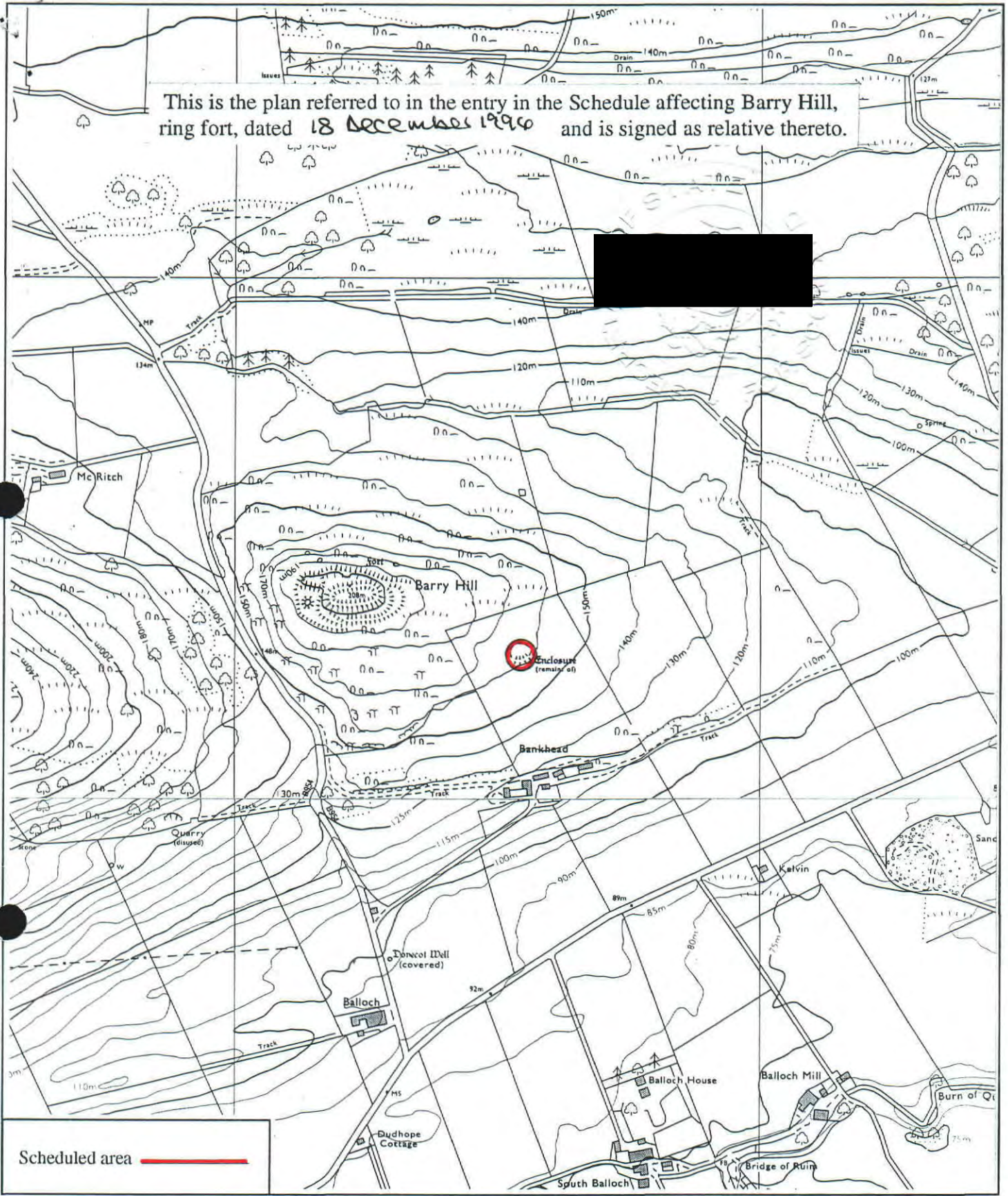
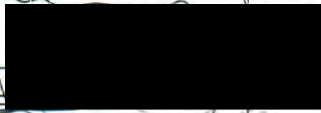

Barry Hill, ring fort

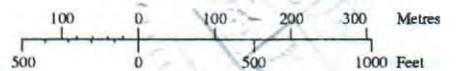
