ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cromlix Lodge, long cairn 1000m WNW of comprises the remains of a long cairn of Neolithic date surviving as a grassed-over stony mound. The area to be scheduled encompasses the cairn and an area around it in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is rectangular with maximum dimensions of 115m WNW-ESE by 45m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dunblane and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and

hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

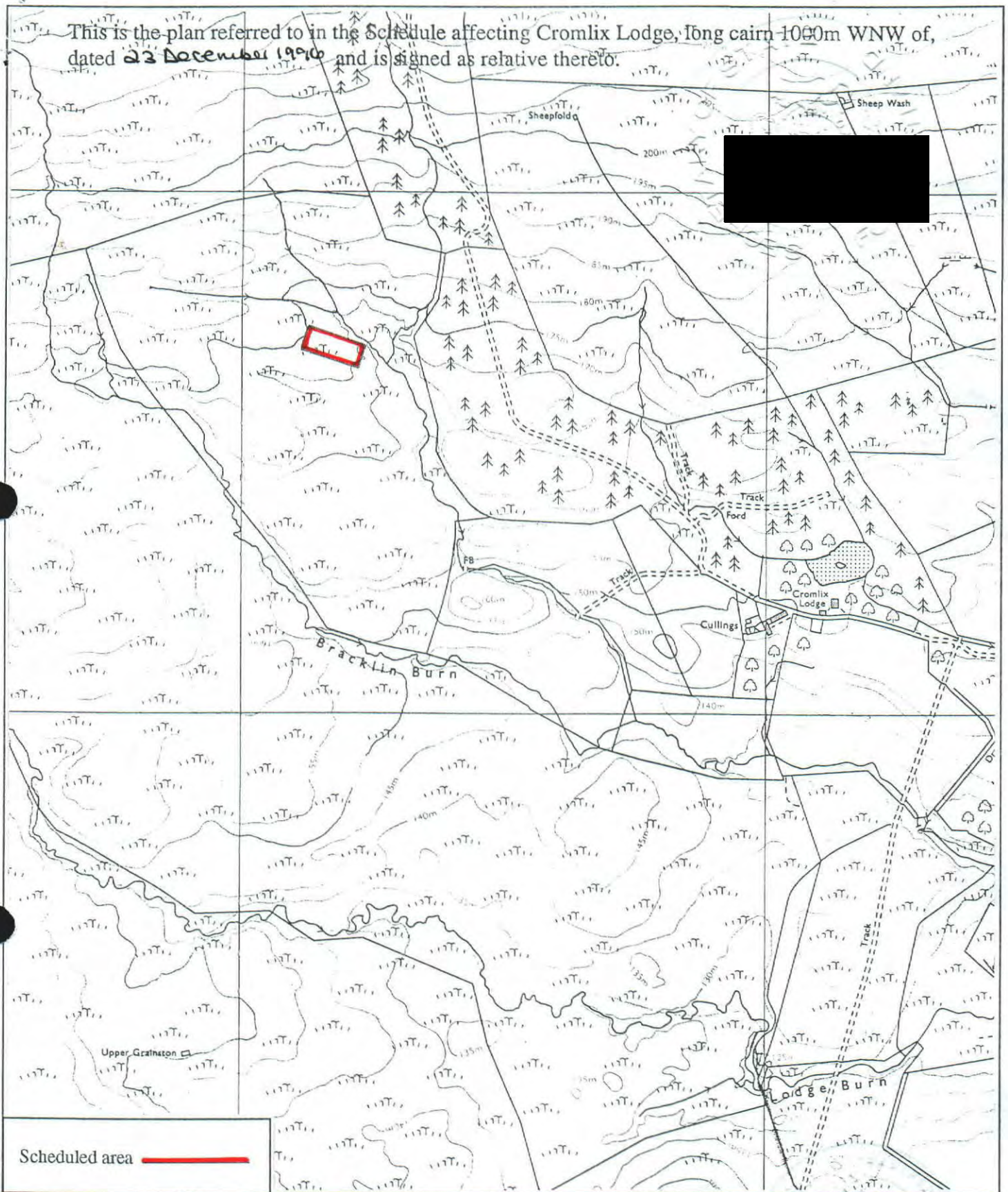

Scheduled area 

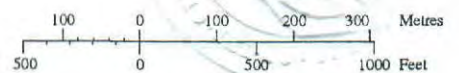
Cromlix Lodge, long cairn 1000m
