ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as The Mound, motte, Grange of Barry comprises the remains of a motte of early medieval date surviving as an earthen mound. The area to be scheduled encompasses the motte and an area around it defined by a relatively recent stone dyke. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 40m NW-SE by 35m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Barry and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]
