The monument known as Hare Cairn, cairn, Bractullo Muir, comprises the remains of a burial cairn of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the visible remains and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 60m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Monikie and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

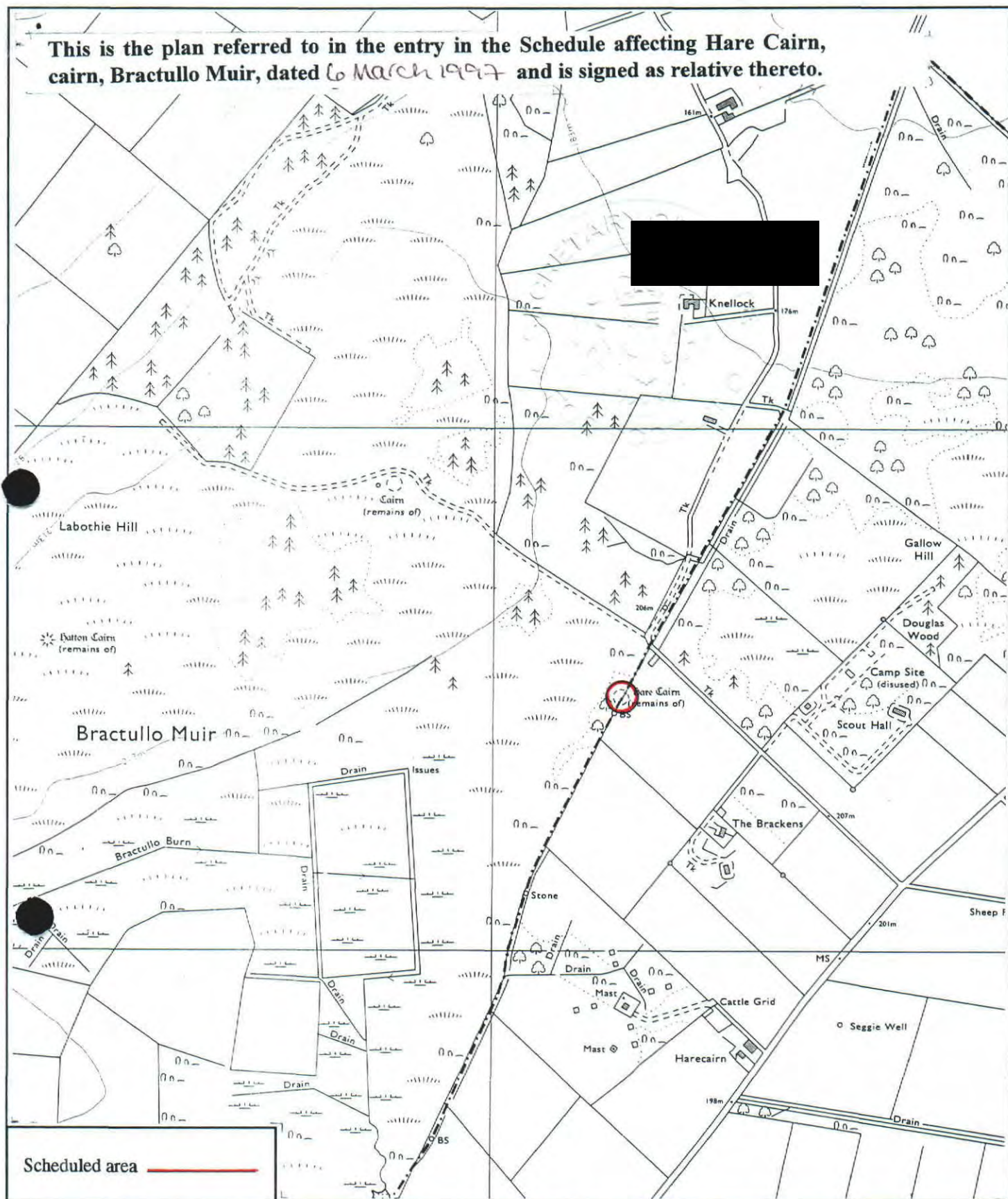

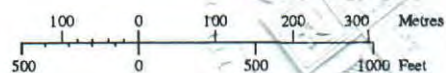
