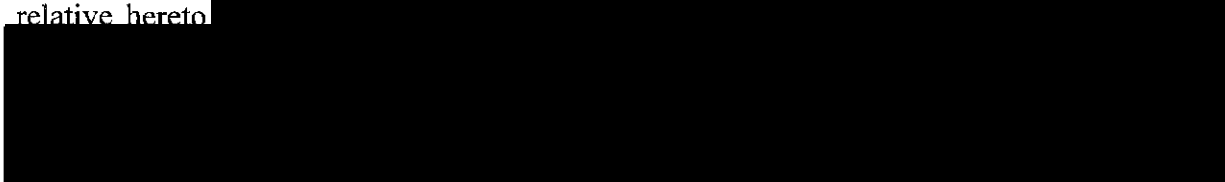

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Hynd Castle, tower house, West Skichen comprises the remains of a small tower house and associated structures. The area to be scheduled encompasses the remains of the castle and the associated structures, and an area around them in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 60m E-W by 50m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Monikie and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

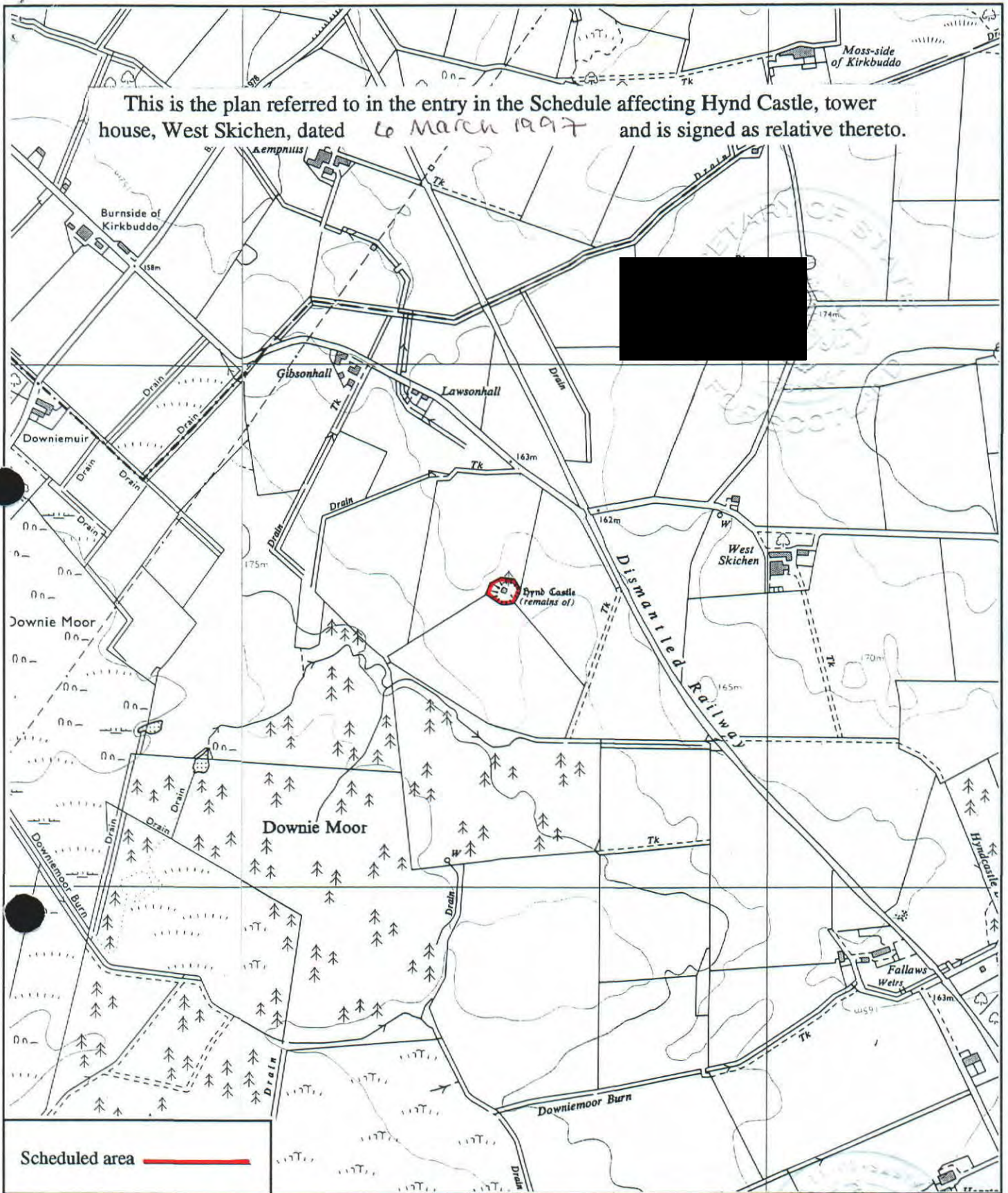
