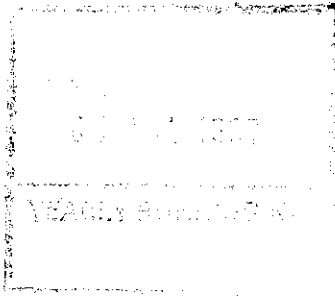

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Banff, St Mary's parish church and burial ground comprises the remains of the old parish church of Banff and its surrounding burial ground. The area to be scheduled comprises the entire burial ground containing the remains of St Mary's church, including the enclosing walls, railings and gates, forming an area extending some 50m E-W by 50m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Banff and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

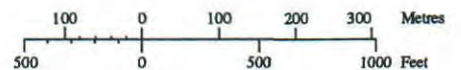
Banff, St Mary's parish church and burial ground
