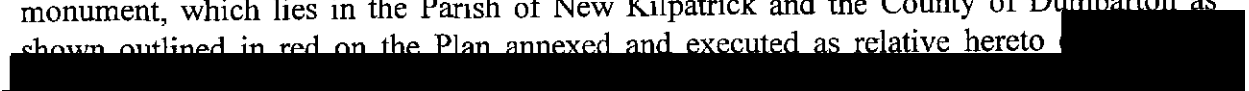

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Forth and Clyde Canal: Linnvale-Duntreath Avenue comprises that length of inland waterway forming part of the Forth and Clyde Canal falling within the boundary of the civil parish of New Kilpatrick and the boundary of Clydebank District. The length of the monument is approximately 1/2 mile (800m) and runs from a point 600m west of the bascule bridge at Linnvale (on the west) to a point 200m west of Duntreath Avenue (on the east). The monument includes the entire length in water together with the banks on either side and the towing path running along one side. In addition, the monument includes the following canal structure: the bascule bridge at Linnvale. The monument does not include any (modern) fences or walls, but does include an area to either side of the area in water in which traces of activities associated with its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of New Kilpatrick and the County of Dumbarton as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section I(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

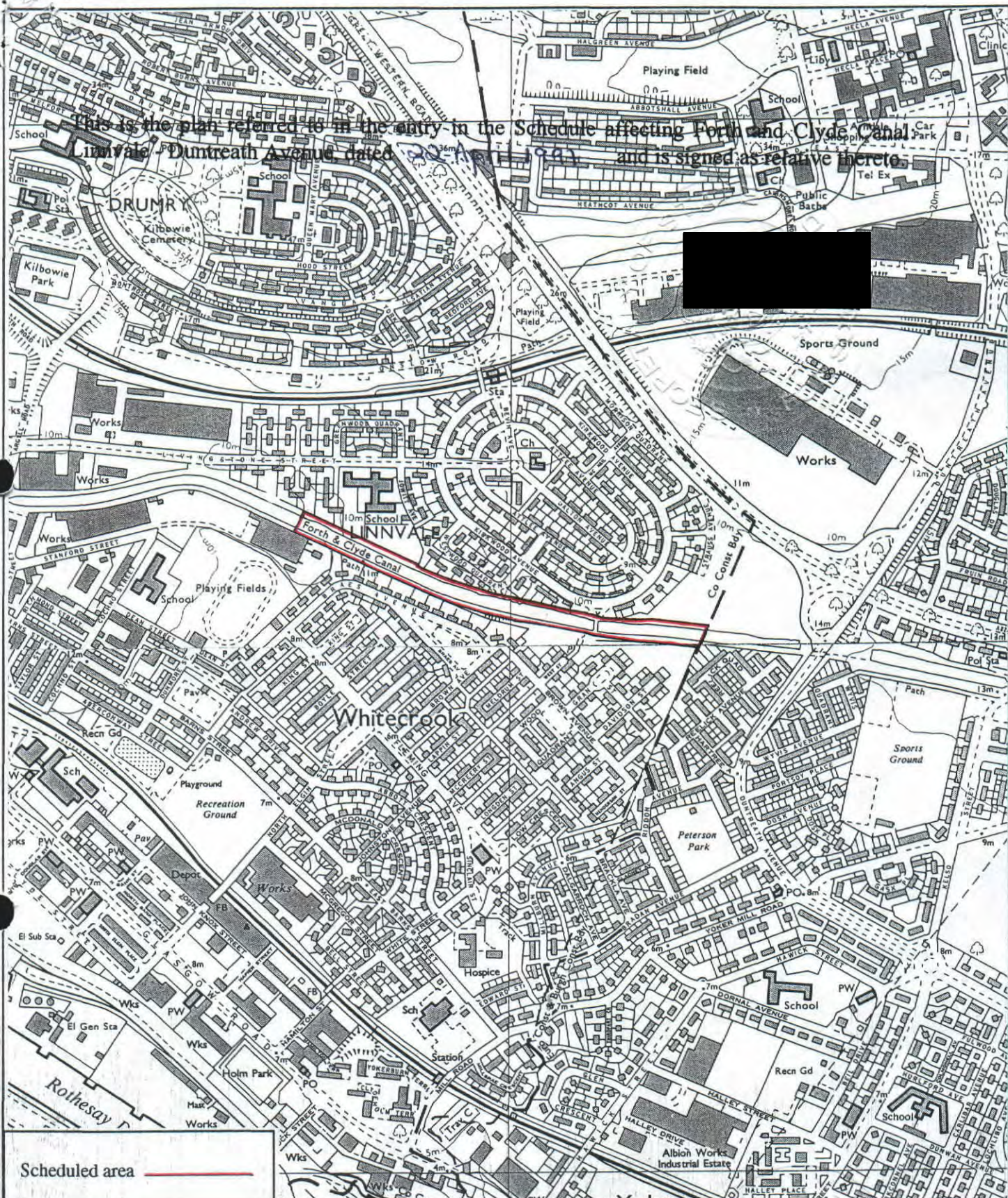

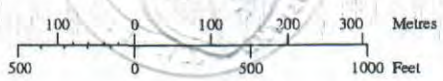
