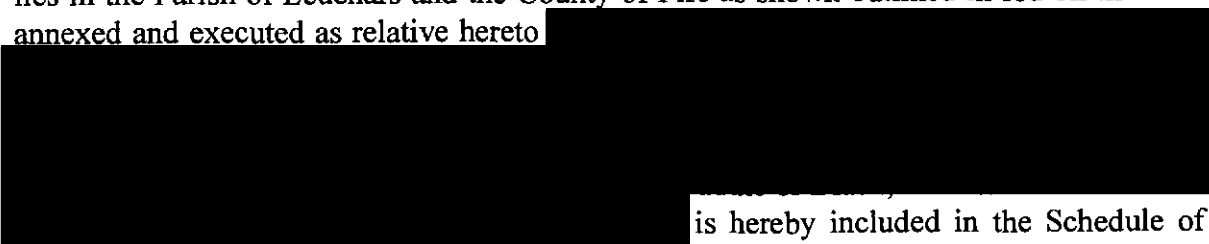

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Earlsall, enclosures and settlements NNW of comprises a series of rectilinear enclosures, probably of both prehistoric and medieval date, visible as cropmarks on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 290m NE-SW by 610m NNW-SSE. To the S its boundary is partly defined by Earlsall Road; to the E partly by the track to Pitlethie; and to the W by the edge of a modern housing estate. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Leuchars and the County of Fife as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

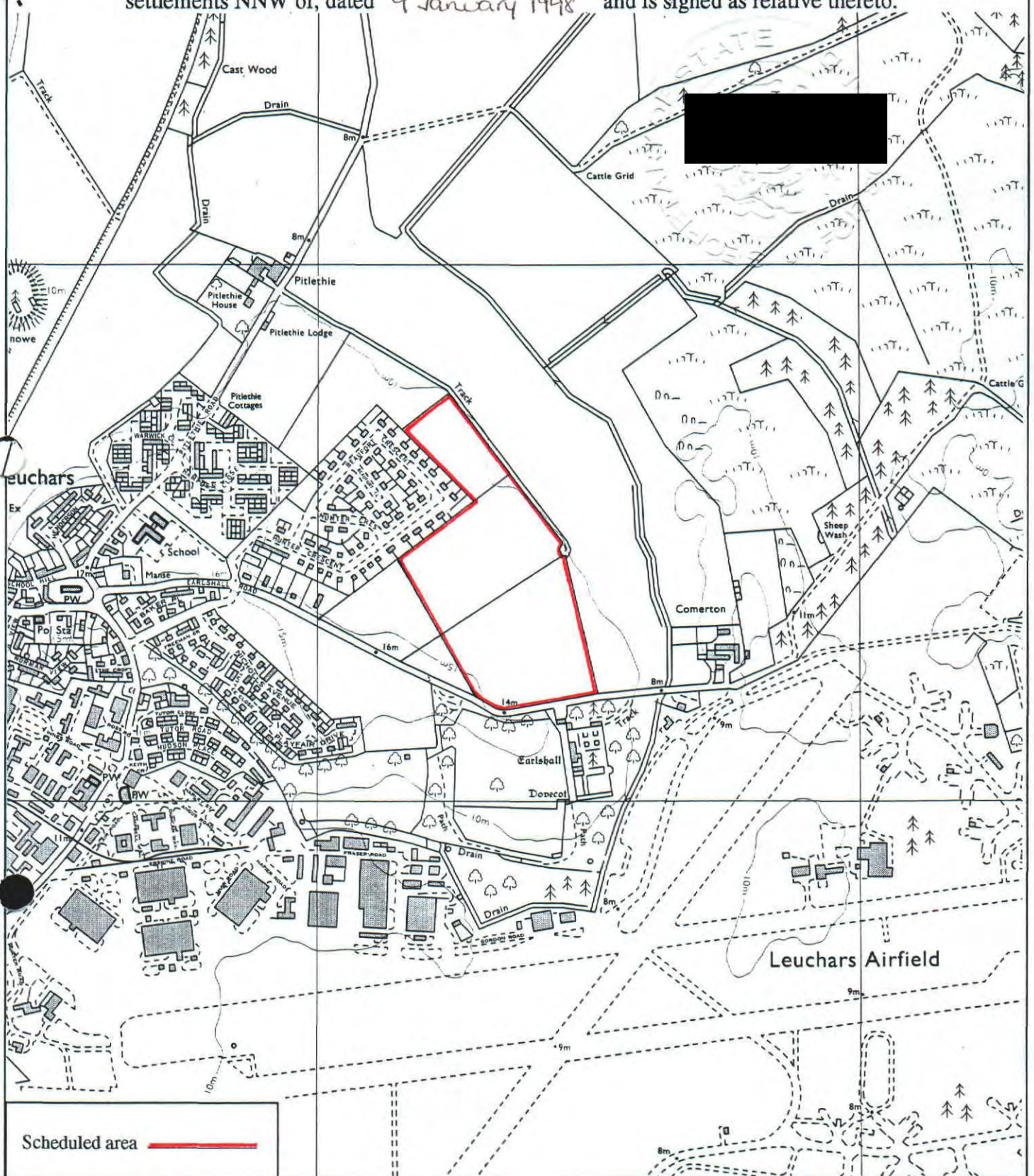

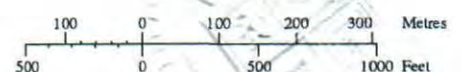
Earls Hall, enclosures and settlements NNW of
