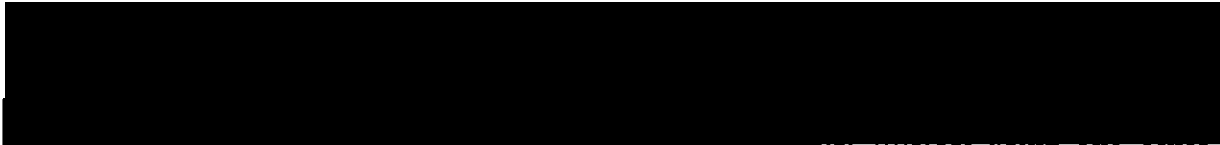

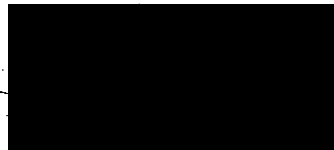

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Hawk Hill, cairn comprises the remains of a burial cairn of prehistoric date surviving as a grass-covered mound. The area to be scheduled encompasses the cairn and an area around it in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is approximately semi-circular with a maximum diameter of 40m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Alloa and the County of Clackmannan as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section I(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

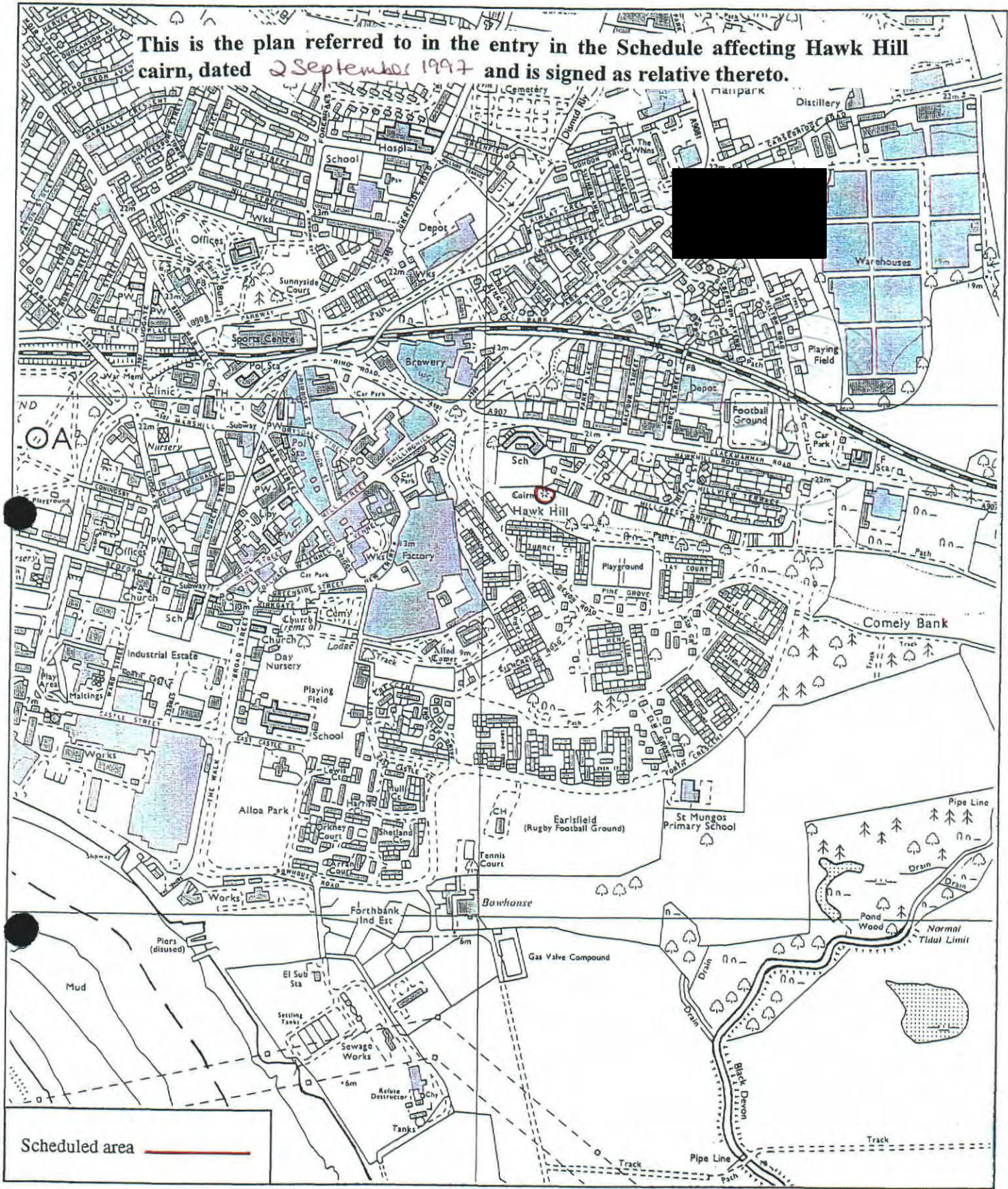

Scheduled area —

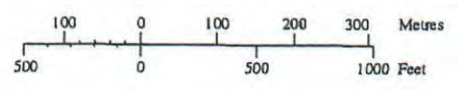
Hawk Hill cairn
