The monument known as Dasher, fort 600m ENE of comprises the remains of a fort of prehistoric date surviving as a series of earthworks. The area to be scheduled encompasses the fort and an area around it in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 100m NE-SW by 70m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kippen and the County of Stirling as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

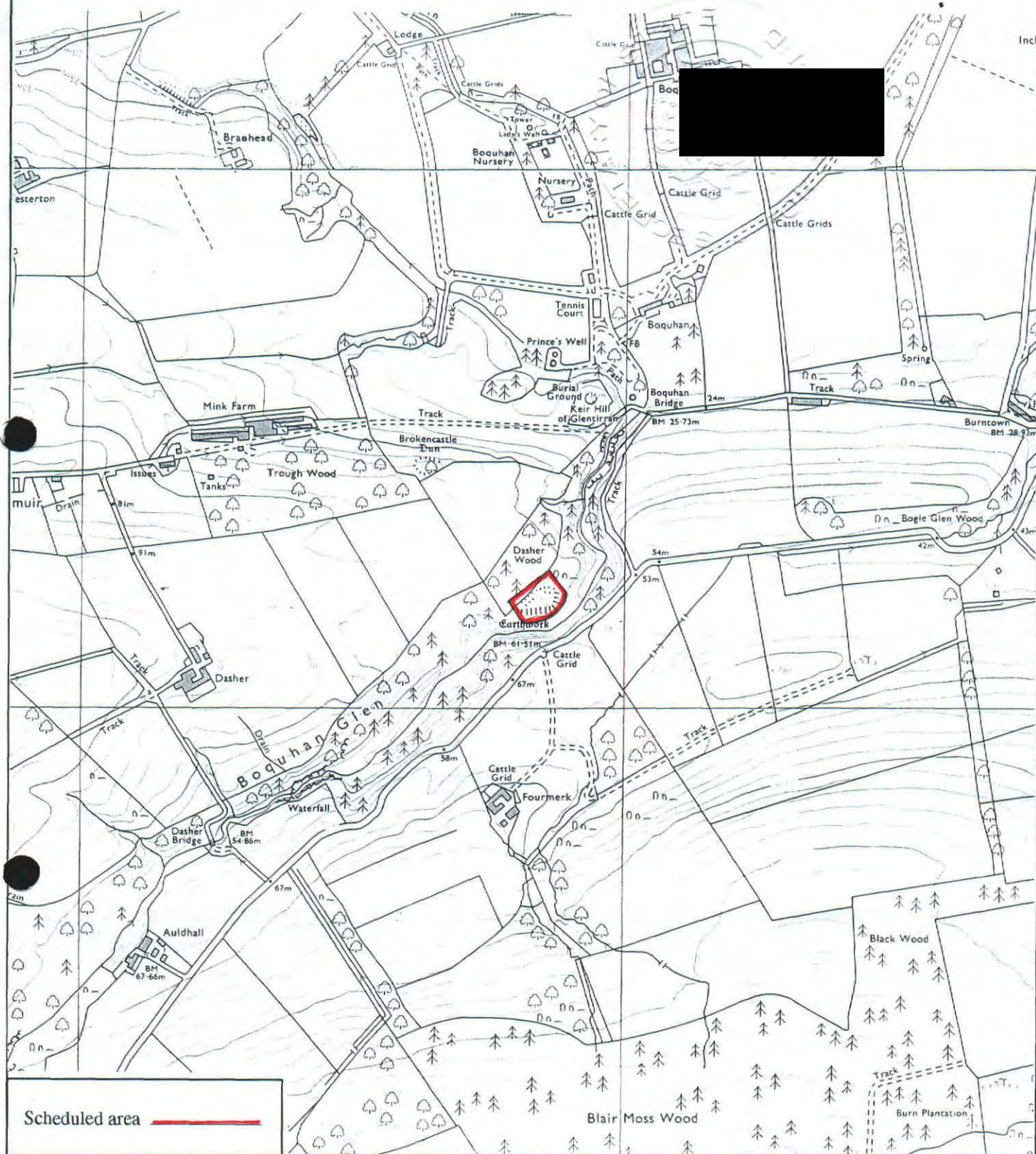

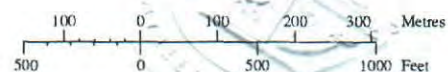
Dasher, fort 600m ENE of
