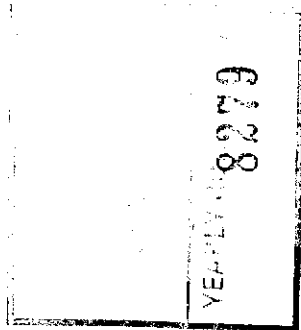

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Dun Ardtreck, galleried dun, Skye comprises the remains of a galleried dun or semi-broch on Ardtreck Point on the Isle of Skye. The area to be scheduled includes the whole top of the knoll outcrop and is an irregular D-shape on plan, measuring 44m NNW-SSE by 32m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Bracadale and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

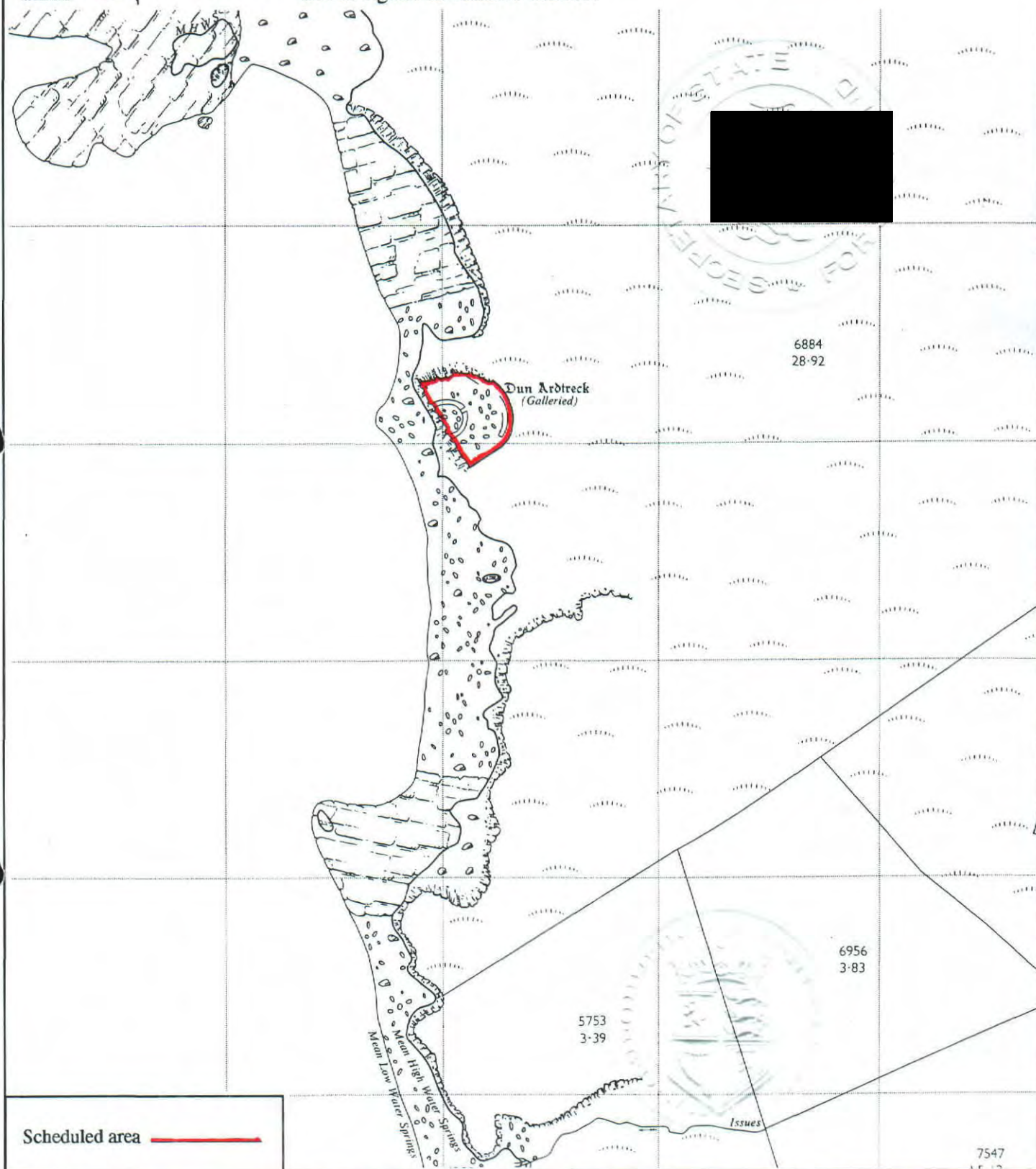

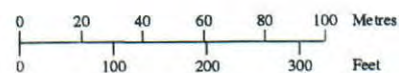
