ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Teampull and Tobar Chaluim Chille, church and well, Balivanich comprises a ruined church and nearby well. The monument to be scheduled comprises two discrete areas: a circular area of ground, 100m in diameter, centred on the centre point of the church; and a second circular area of ground, 10m in diameter, centred on the well. The monument, which lies in the Parish of South Uist and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

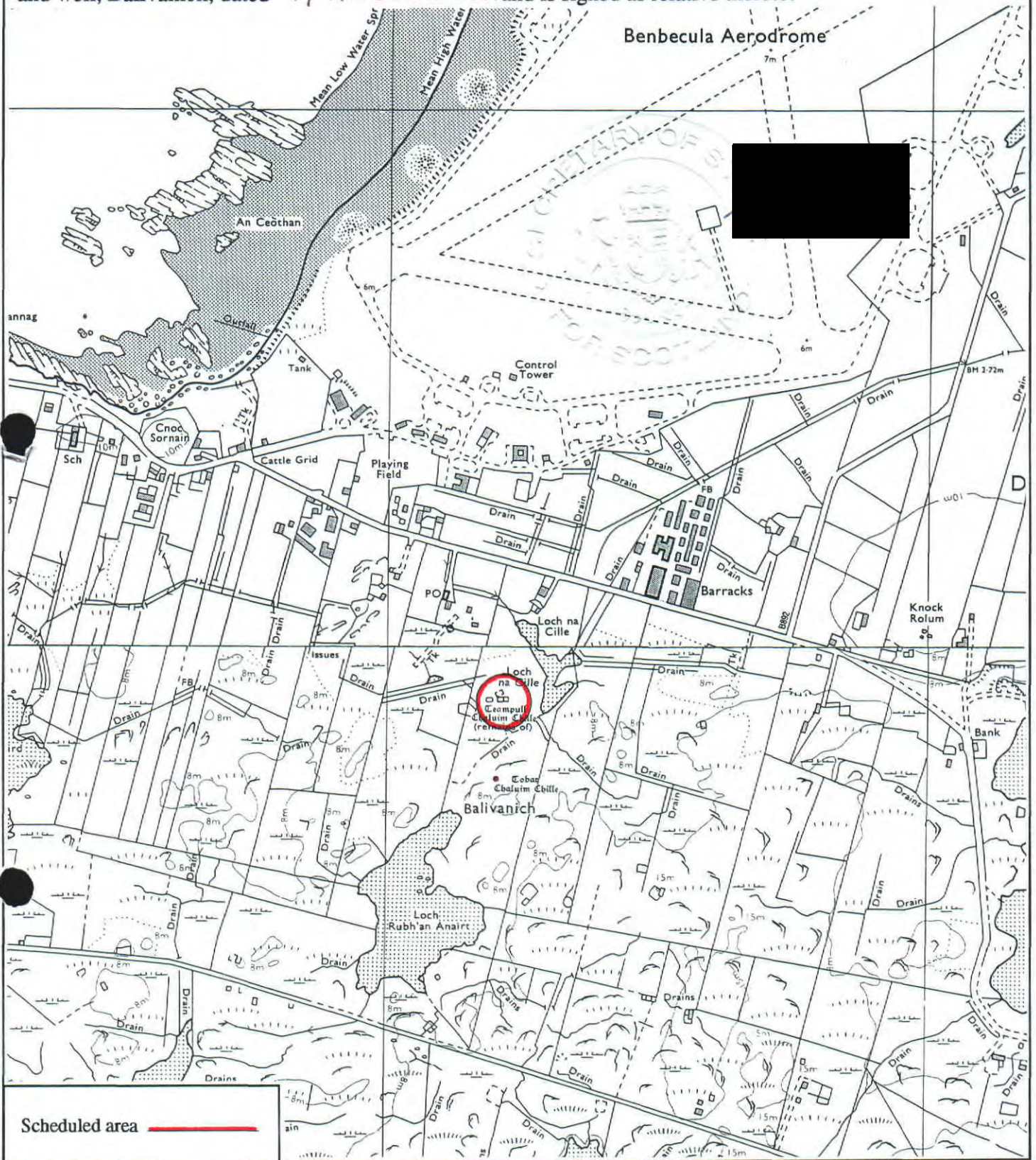

Scheduled area 

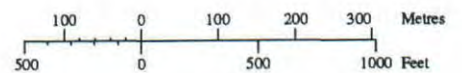
