ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Old Deer, Old Parish Church comprises the remains of the old parish church which lie immediately E of the present parish church in the centre of Old Deer, incorporated into two contiguous walled roofless burial enclosures, separated by the medieval chancel arch. The monument to be scheduled comprises both burial enclosures, the ground enclosed by them and the ground extending for 2m from their outer wall face; an area measuring some 23m E-W by 12.05m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Old Deer and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

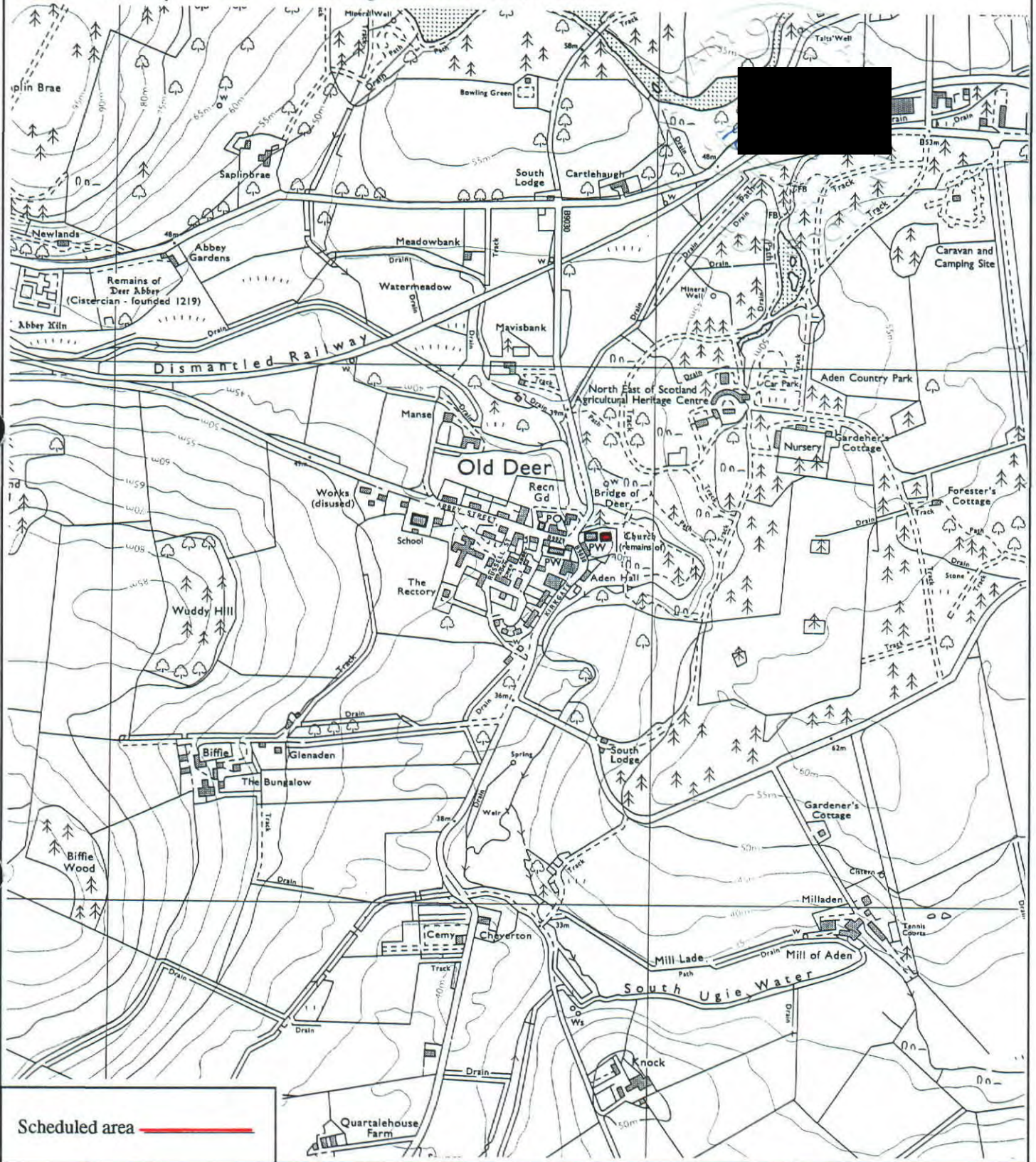

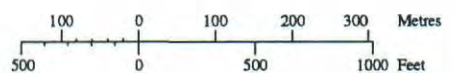
Old Deer, Old Parish Church
