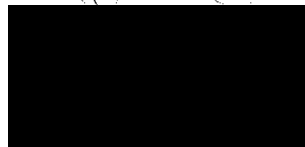

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Fetterangus Church comprises the remains of Fetterangus Church. The area to be scheduled includes the remains of the church and a strip of ground extending 3m out from its walls, forming an area measuring 17.7m by 11.75m overall. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Old Deer and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

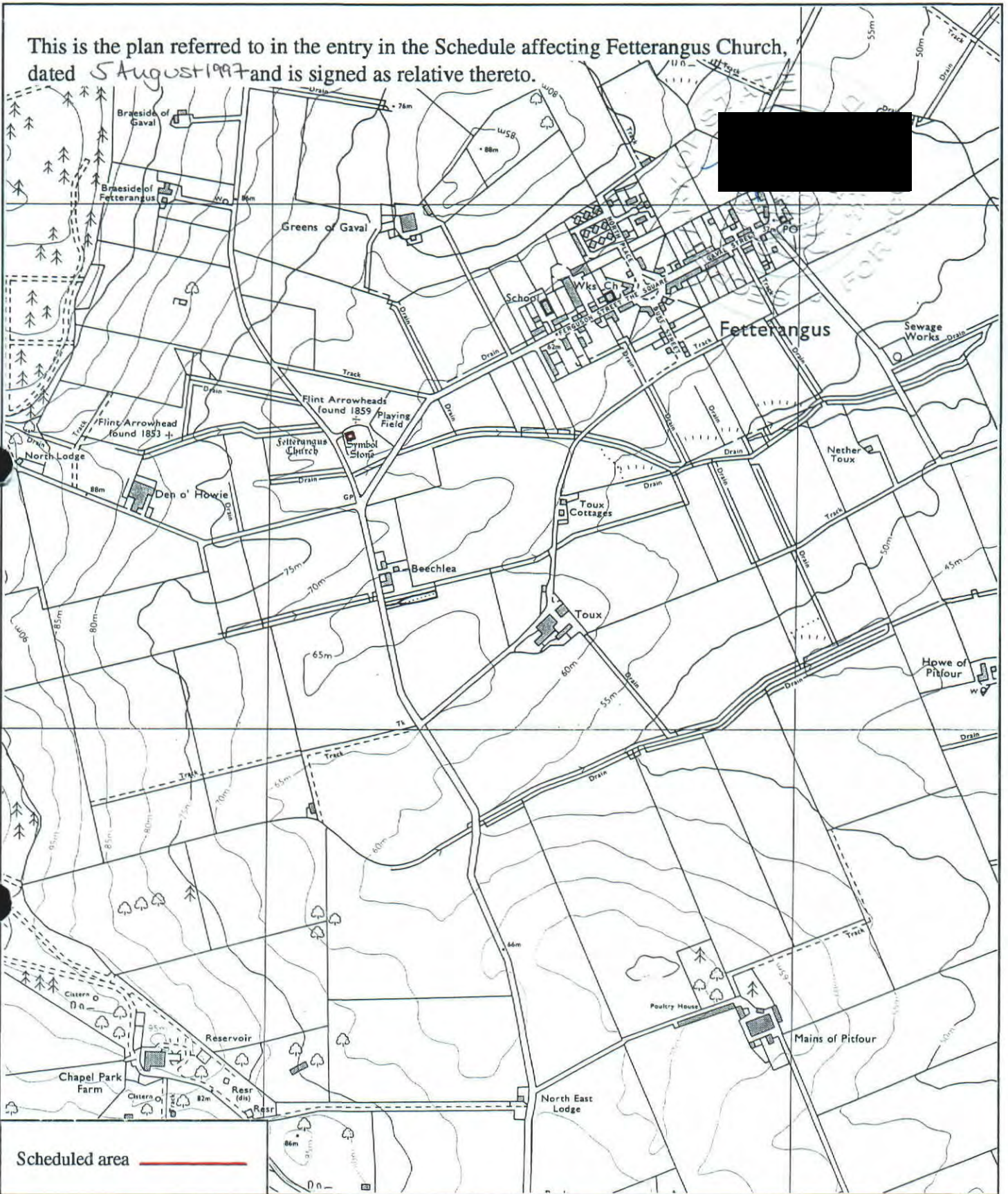

Scheduled area

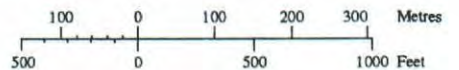
**Fetterangus Church**
