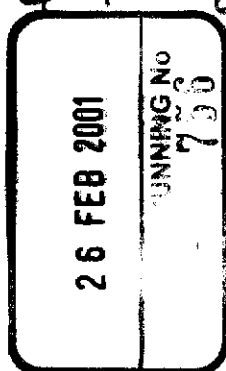

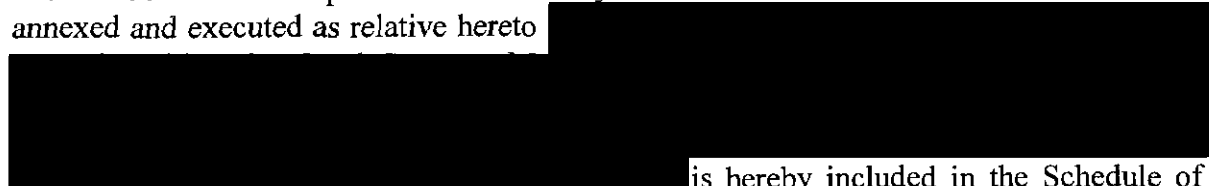

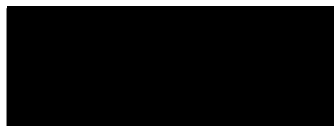
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Fingask Castle, standing stone 320m SSE of comprises a standing stone of prehistoric date, visible as an upstanding monument. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 10m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilspindie and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

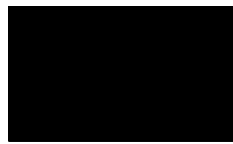

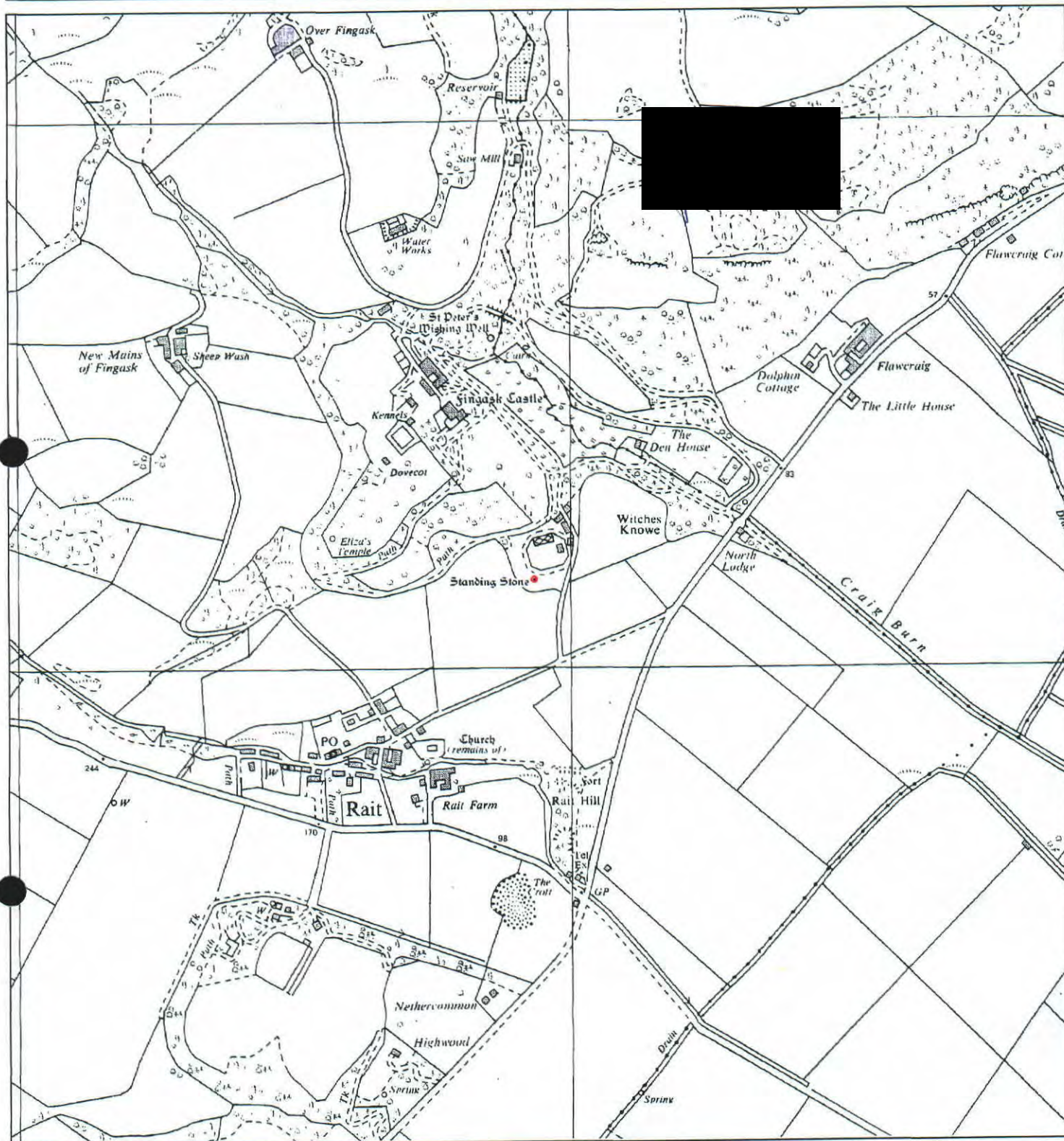
