

The monument known as Gallowflat, unenclosed settlement 150m NE of comprises an unenclosed settlement of prehistoric date, visible as a series of cropmarks on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 110m. 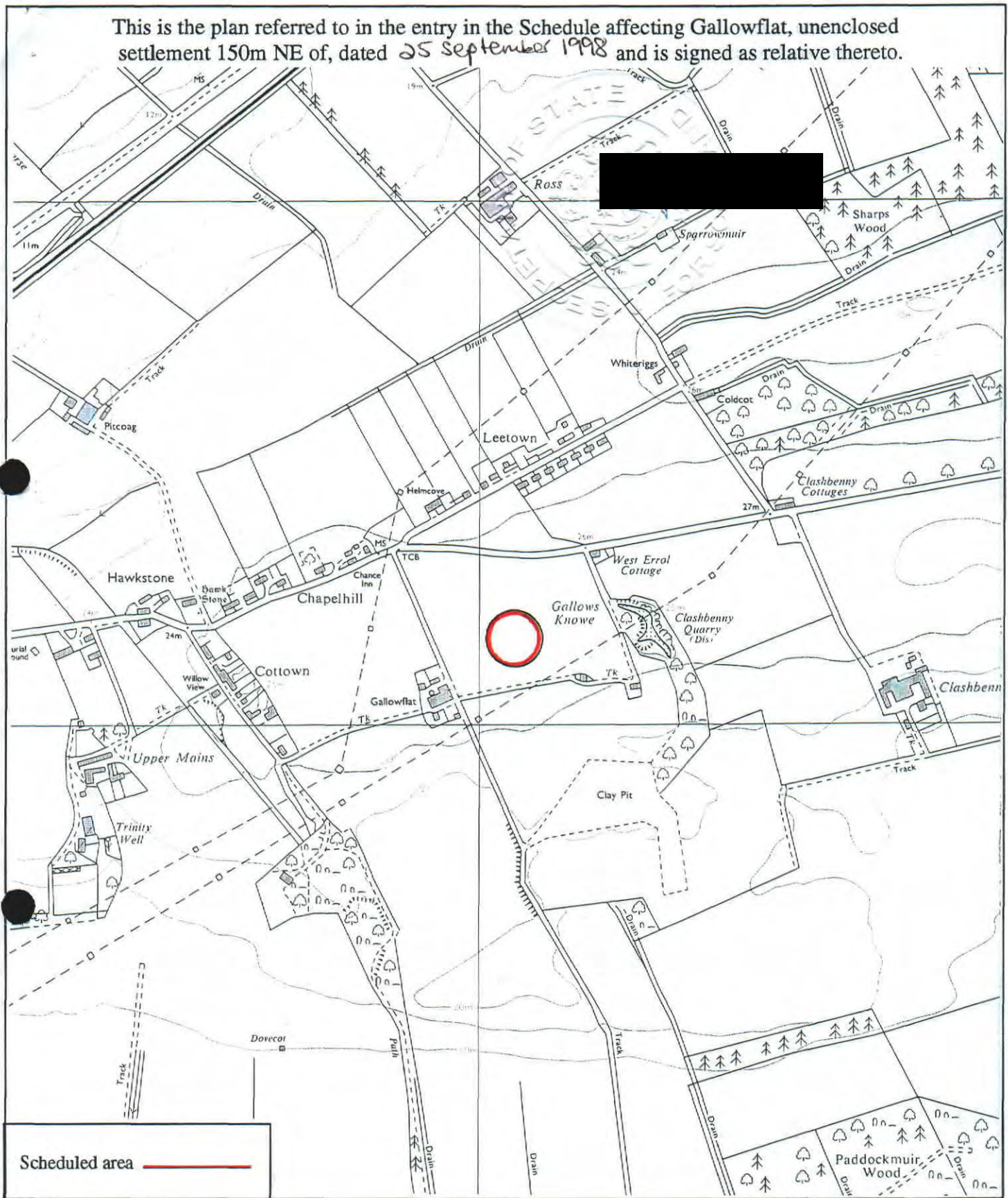

Scheduled area

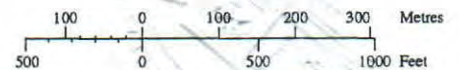
