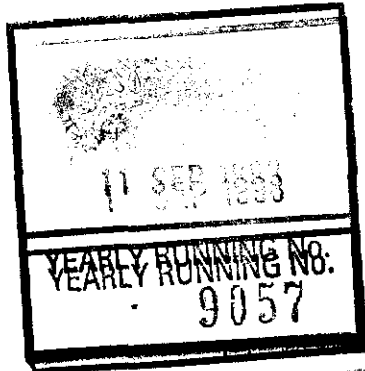

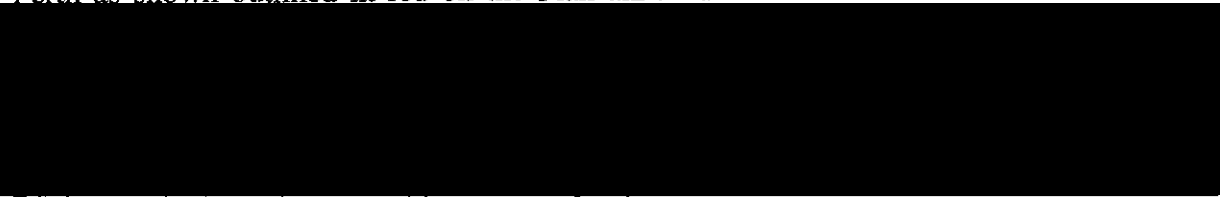

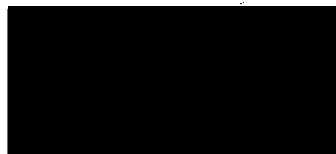
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Inchyra Farm, unenclosed settlement 500m NE of comprises an unenclosed settlement of prehistoric date, visible as a series of cropmarks on oblique aerial photographs. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 85m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of St Madoes and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

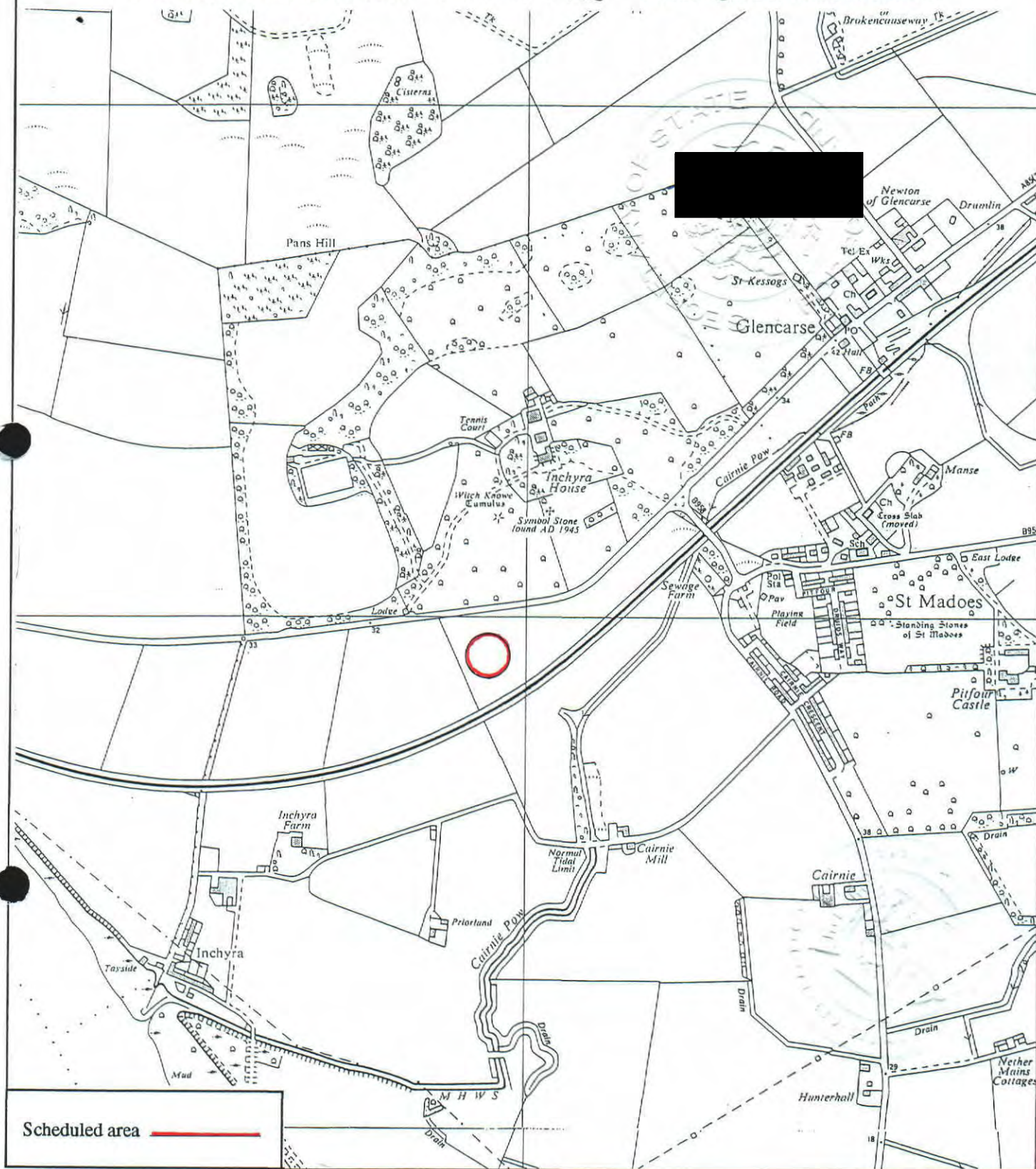

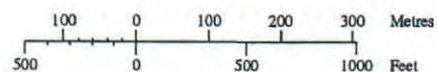
Inchyra Farm, unenclosed settlement
