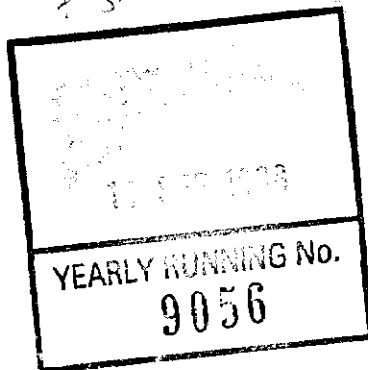

The monument known as Witch Knowe, barrow 130m SW of Inchyra House comprises a burial mound of Later Neolithic or Bronze Age date, visible as a grass-covered mound. The area to be scheduled comprises the mound and an area around it within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 45m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of St Madoes and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of

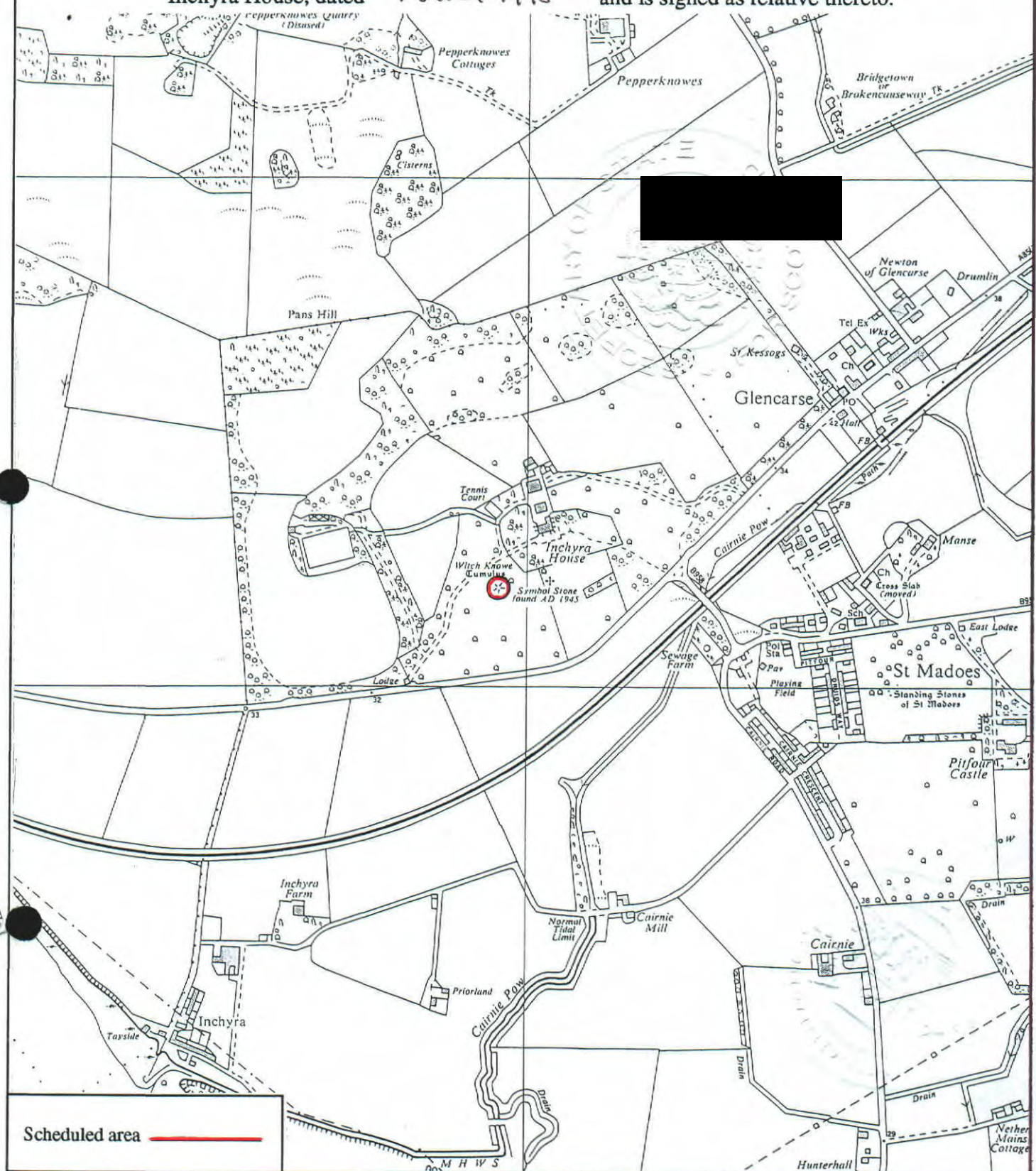

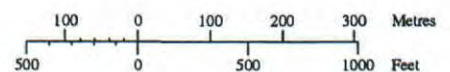
