ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Kirkmaiden Church, church and churchyard 500m N of Mull of Galloway Farm comprises a church and burial-ground of Medieval date, dedicated to St Medana. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. The modern dykes overlying the churchyard wall are specifically excluded from the scheduling. The scheduled area is irregular in shape, with maximum dimensions of 60m E-W by 60m N-S. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkmaiden and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

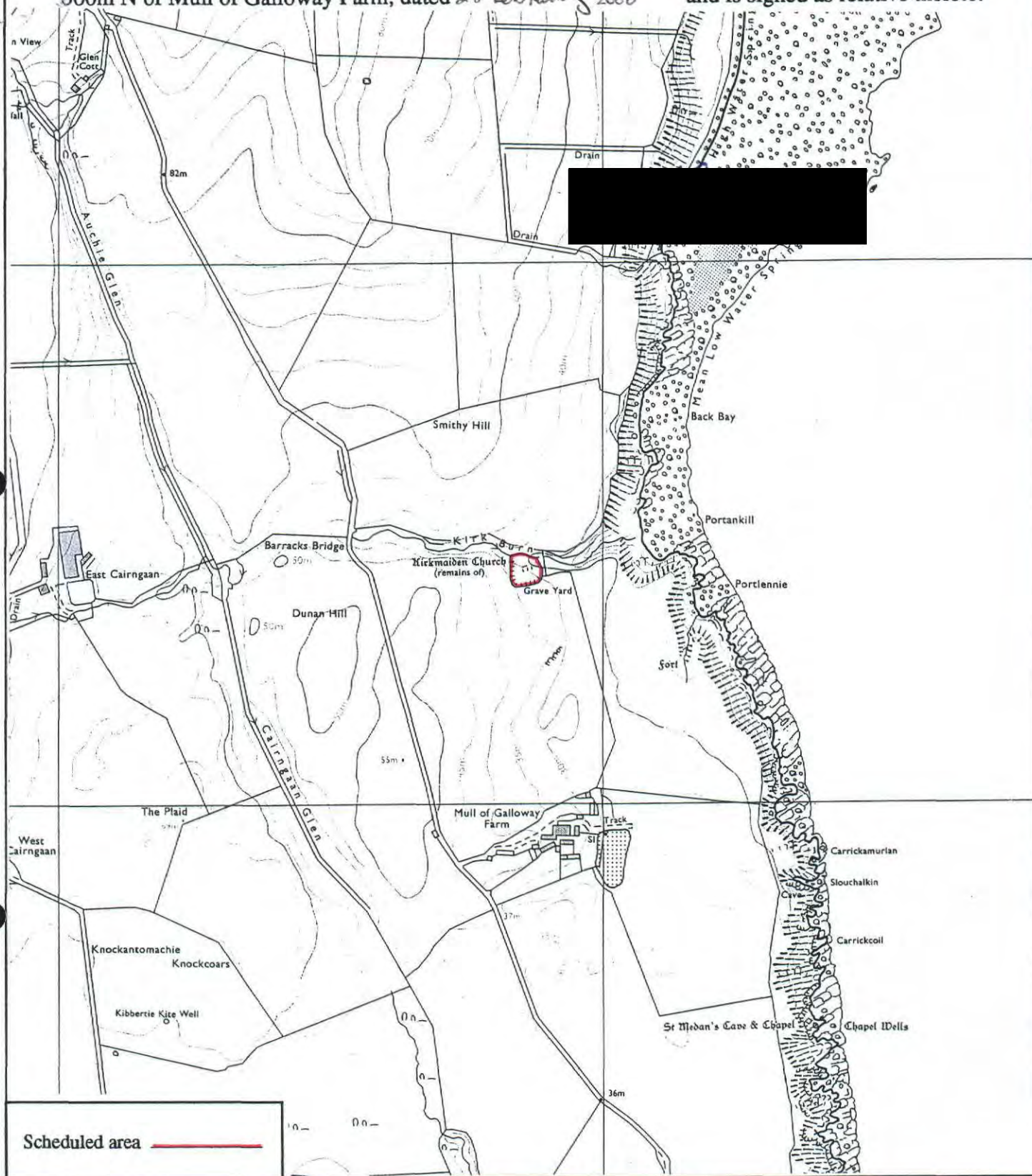

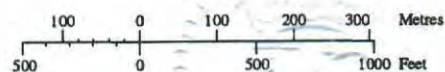
Kirkmaiden Church, church and churchyard 500m N of Mull of Galloway Farm
