





ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cults Loch, crannog 770m ESE of Castle Kennedy House comprises a crannog of prehistoric date, visible as a stony mound. The area to be scheduled comprises the crannog as described and an area of the loch bed around it within which related material may be expected to be found. It is circular with a diameter of 40m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inch and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto 

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

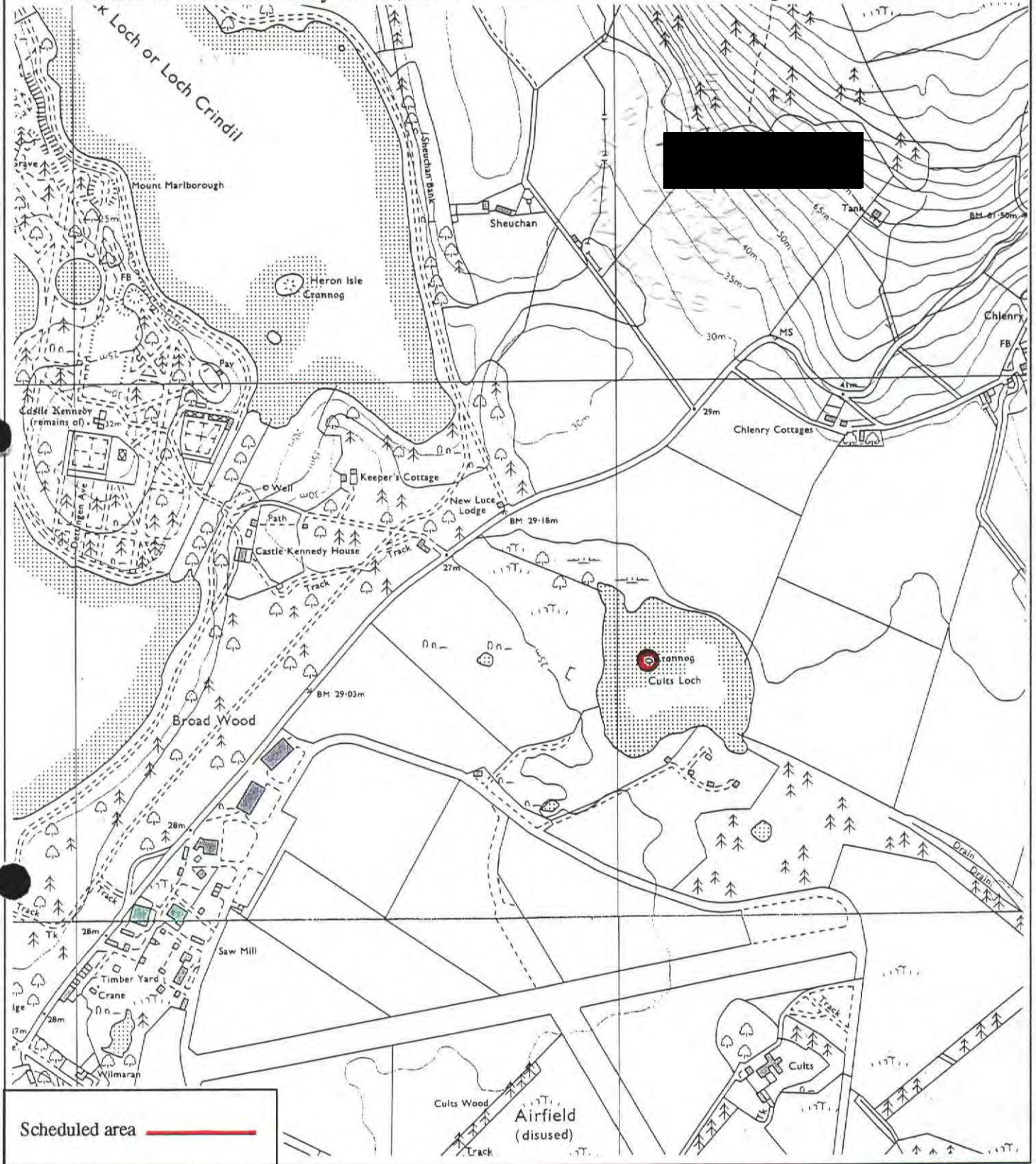

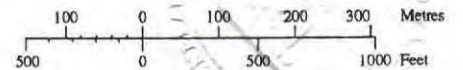
Cults Loch, crannog 770m ESE of
