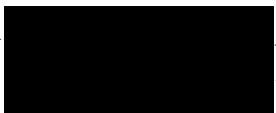

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Aberdeenshire Canal, remains of, N and E of Tillybrig Cottage, Dyce comprises the remains of a stretch of the Aberdeenshire Canal Navigation, or Aberdeen-Inverurie Canal. The monument to be scheduled comprises the canal bed, the enclosing embankments and a strip 2m wide to either side, extending from the foot of the road embankment in the N to the NW foot of the stone field boundary in the S, representing an area measuring some 260m in length and up to 30m in width. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dyce and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

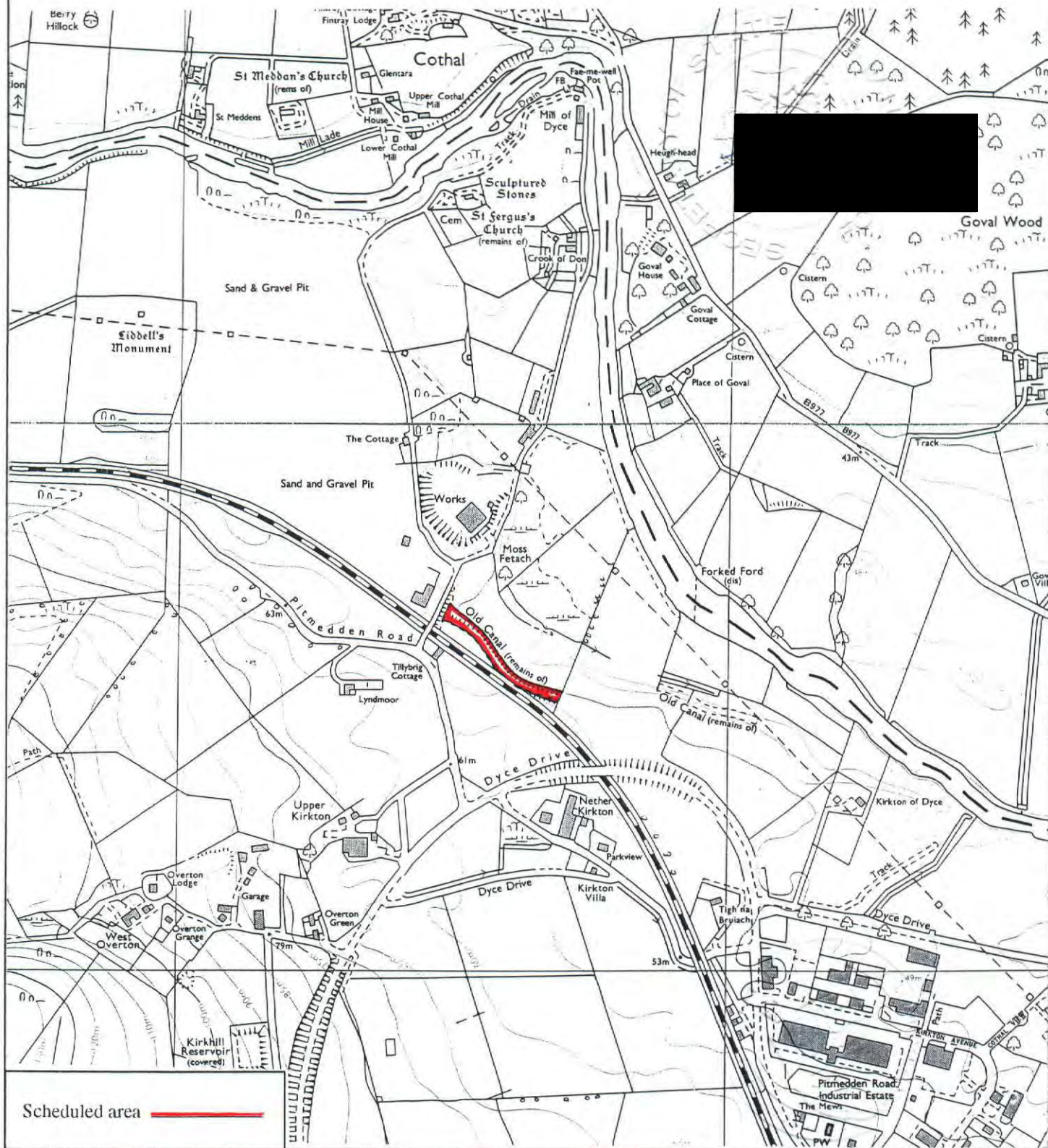




Aberdeenshire Canal, remains of, N and E of Tillybrig Cottage, Dyce
