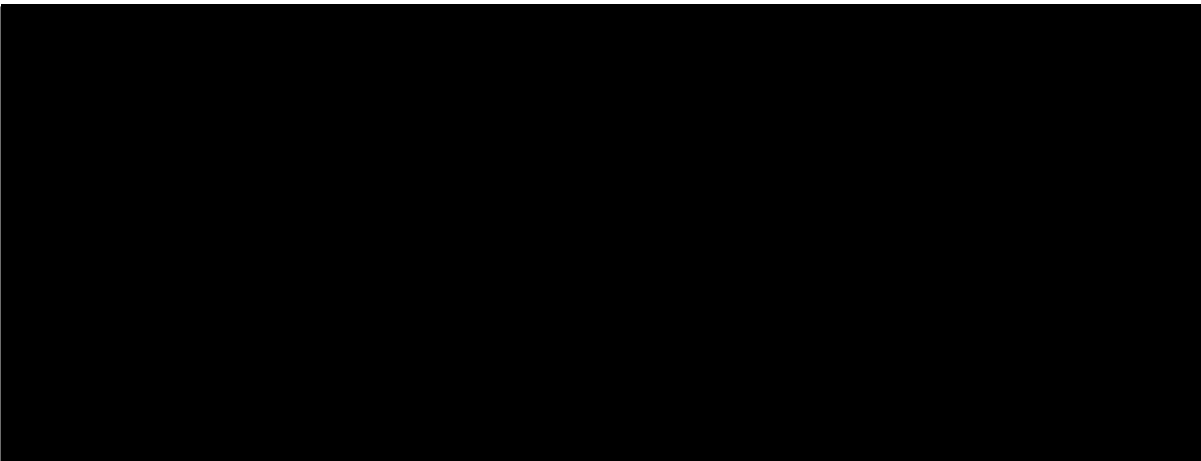

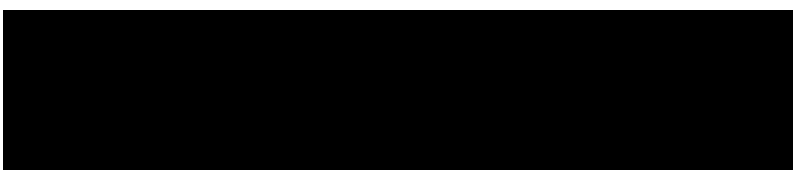

The monument known as Benarty Hill, fort comprises a fort, irregular in shape, of prehistoric date, visible as upstanding remains. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is polygonal, measuring 350m E-W by 290m NNW-SSE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Cleish and straddles the boundary of the Counties of Kinross and Fife as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



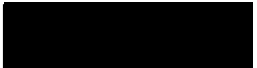

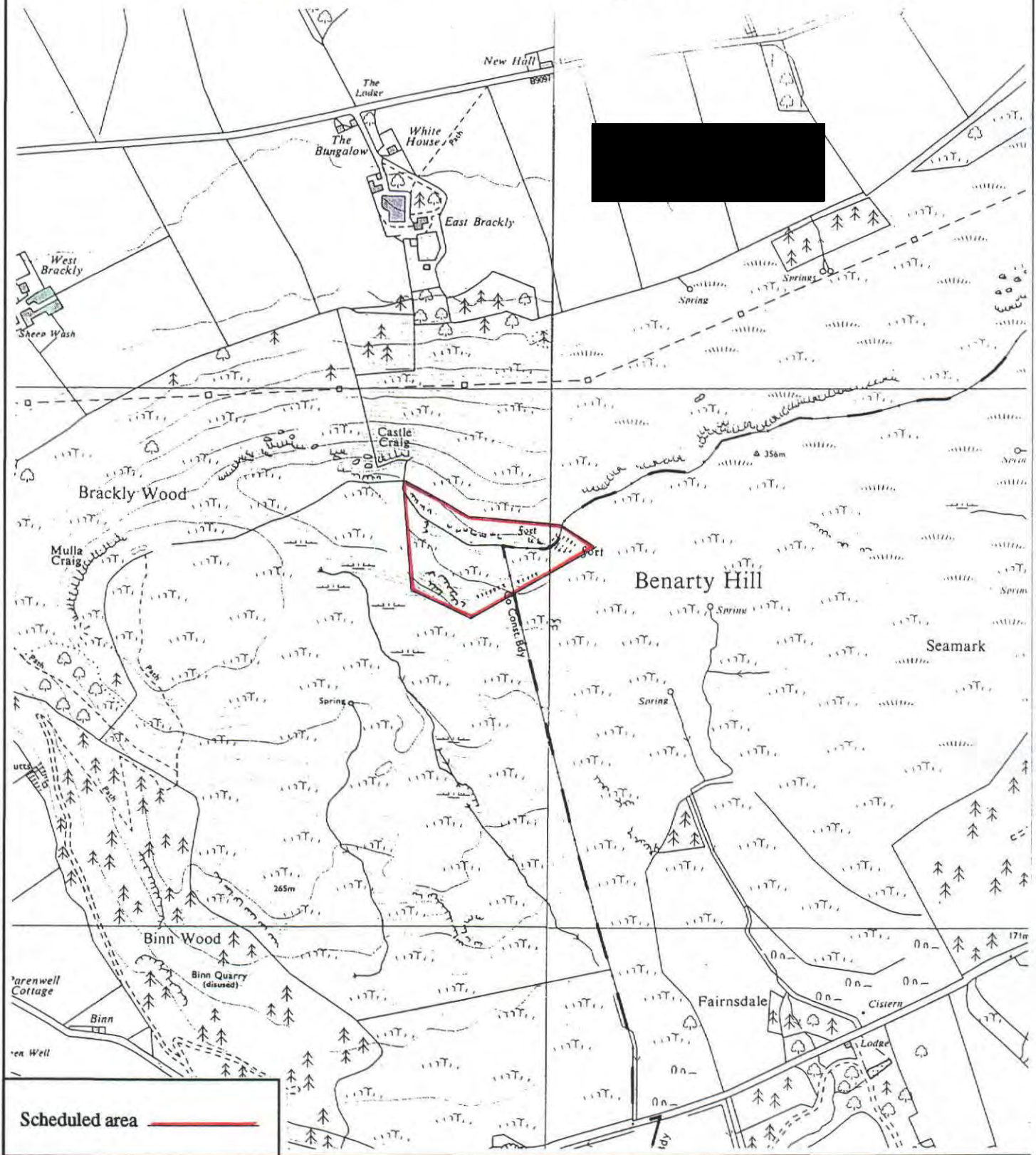

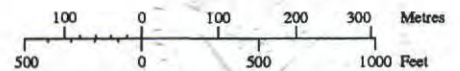
