ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Down Hill, fort, Glen Devon comprises a well-preserved fort of prehistoric date, visible as a series of upstanding earthworks. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is an irregular oval, with maximum dimensions NW-SE of 220m and NE-SW of 165m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glendevon and the County of Perth as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

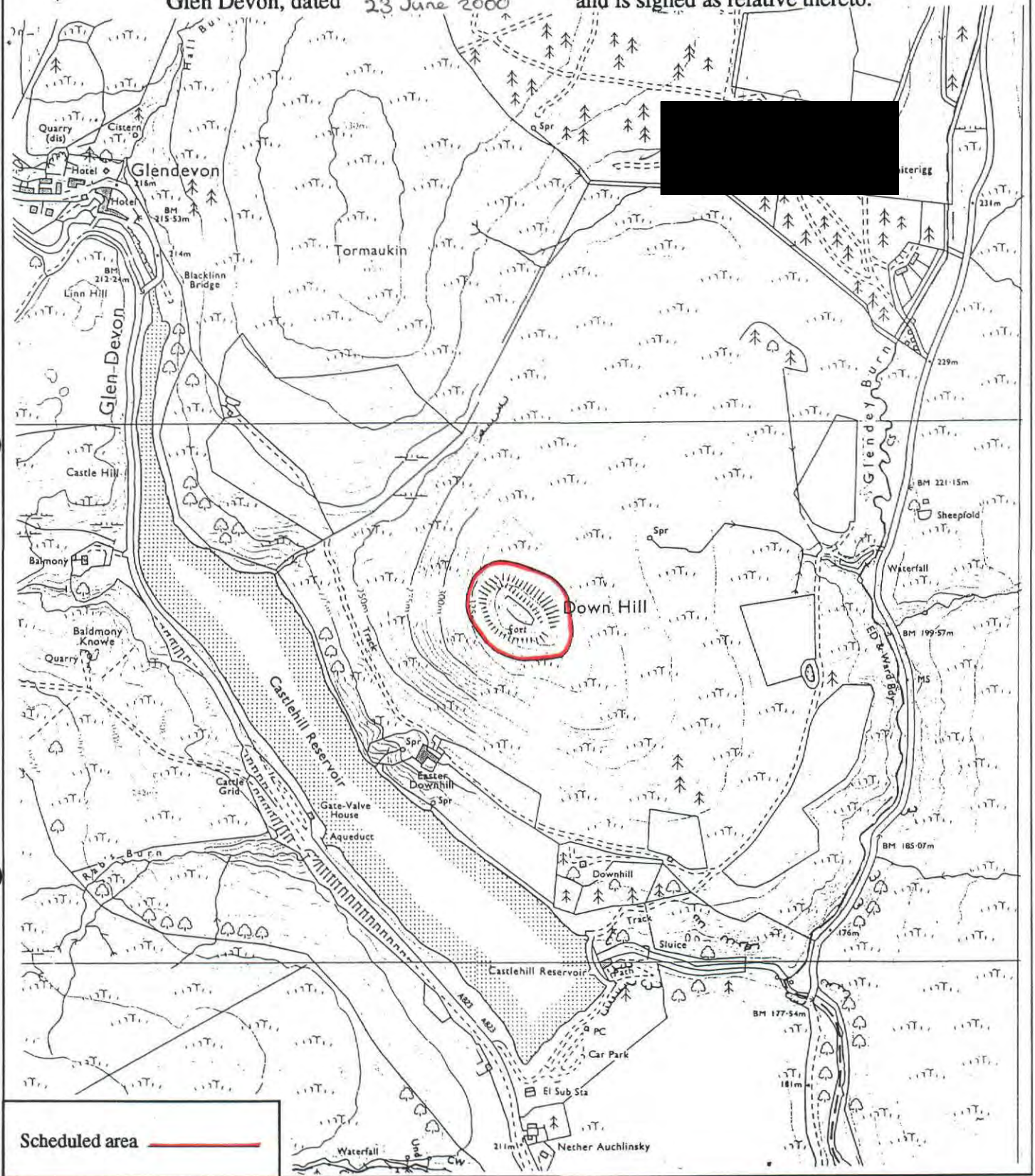

Scheduled area

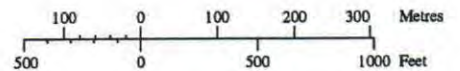
Down Hill, fort, Glen Devon
